The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board met via WebEx videoconference, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

MS. FLETCHER: Good morning, everyone. My name is LaVerne Fletcher. I'll be conducting the roll call hearings as the Board's agent. Thank you for participating in ABRA's roll call hearing via WebEx platform.

There is one case on the calendar today. Let's see. Is anyone here on behalf of the applicant at this point? Is anyone present on behalf of Xscape?

Is anyone present on behalf of ANC 5B?
MS. PIEKARA: I am here on behalf of ANC 5B.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, if you could just state your name and spell it for the record, please?

MS. FLETCHER: Sure. Prita Piekara. P as in Paul, R-I T as on Tom, A. Last name is Piekara. P as in Paul, I-E-K-A-R-A. And I am the commissioner for ANC 5B06.

MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Piekara, is anyone else going to be joining you today?

MS. PIEKARA: Not from 5B, but I do have my colleague from ANC 5C on the line as
well.
MS. FLETCHER: ANC 5C did file a protest. Is anyone present on behalf of ANC 5C? MR. KAPUR: Yes. This is Vijay Kapur, full legal name, V-I-J-A-Y. Last name is K-A-P-U-R. I am the Commissioner representing SingleMember District 5C07.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. The applicant has not yet arrived. We allow ten minutes for people to show up in case they're having any technical difficulties. And so the time is 10:04, so we'll wait an additional six minutes for the applicant to appear.

At this point I have not heard from the applicant one way or the other, but he has a few minutes to show up.

Okay, so the applicant has appeared. If you would state your name and spell it for the record, please.

MS. NWAEZE: My name is Grace Nwaeze. G-R-A-C-E N-W-A-E-Z-E.

MS. FLETCHER: Grace, would you pronounce your last name one more time?

MS. NWAEZE: Nwaeze, the $N$ is silent.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. The N is
silent. Thank you very much.
MS. NWAEZE: You're welcome.
MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Nwaeze, the ANC representative for 5B is present.

Ms. Piekara, could you introduce yourself one more time, please?

MS. PIEKARA: Sure. I'm ANC
Commissioner for Single Member District 5B06. My name is Prita Piekara. Do you need me to spell it again?

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, and the representative from ANC 5C is also present. Mr. Kapur, could you introduce yourself again, please?

MR. KAPUR: Sure, my name is Vijay Kapur. I am the Commissioner representing Single-Member District 5C07 and I'm here representing 5C in this case.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. ANC 5B has standing as a protestant. ANC 5C has standing as an affected ANC because their boundaries touch those of ANC 5B.

Ms. Nwaeze, any questions about that?
MS. NWAEZE: No.
MS. FLETCHER: We need to set a date
for a mediation, a status hearing, and a protest hearing. I will give you the dates for the status and protest hearing first.

MS. NWAEZE: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: The status hearing is scheduled for July 12th.

MS. NWAEZE: July 12th, okay.
MS. FLETCHER: 2023 at 10:30 a.m.
MS. NWAEZE: 10:30 a.m.
MS. FLETCHER: Yes. The protest hearing is set for August 2nd.

MS. NWAEZE: August 2nd. Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: At 1:30 p.m.
MS. NWAEZE: 1:30 p.m. Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: Yes. And we need to set a date for mediation to occur prior to the status hearing. So I'm going to give you the next dates available. Let's see, is anyone available on Tuesday, June 27th -- first of all, let me say this. Tuesday and Wednesday of this week are also available. I know that's short notice, but if anyone wanted to come this week, the 13th or the 14th, they could.

MS. NWAEZE: I have my nephew's graduation on the 14th.

MS. FLETCHER: Well --
MS. NWAEZE: At 10 a.m.
MS. FLETCHER: Are either one of the ANCs available on tomorrow? I know that's short notice. I could just move on to the 27 th.

MS. PIEKARA: I'm unfortunately unavailable tomorrow, but $I$ am available on the 27th.

MS. FLETCHER: The 27th, any time between 10:30 and 1:30.

MS. PIEKARA: I can be flexible as to what works for everyone else.

MS. NWAEZE: 1:30?
MS. FLETCHER: 1:30. Okay. What about ANC 5C. Are you available at 1:30?

MR. KAPUR: 1:30 Tuesday, June 27th works.

MS. FLETCHER: Yes, thank you. Mediation is set for Tuesday, June 27 th at 1:30 p.m. and I will send you the WebEx invitation to attend mediation.
