3 MS. FLETCHER: Good morning. I would
4 like to thank you for participating in ABRA's
5 roll call hearings via the WebEx platform
6 provided by the DC Office of Open Government. My
7 name is LaVerne Fletcher. It looks like we are
8 live streaming to You Tube now so we can get
9 started.

10 There are four cases on the calendar
11 today. The first case is The Springs. This is
12 Case No. 22-PRO-00037, The Springs, LLC, 1315 I
13 Street NW, License No. ABRA-120472. This is a
14 Retailer Class CT new application. My name is
15 LaVerne Fletcher conducting the roll call hearing
16 as the Board's agent.

17 Is anyone present on behalf of The
18 Springs?

19 MS. YOHANNES: Yes, Sidon Yohannes
20 here on behalf of The Springs. That's S-I-D-O-N
21 Y-O-H-A-N-N-E-S.

22 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms.
23 Yohannes.

24 Is anyone present on behalf of ANC-2F?

25 MS. JOSEPH: Hi, Ms. Fletcher. I'm

1 present. My name is Sherene Joseph, Chair of
2 ANC-2F. That's S-H-E-R-E-N-E, last name is
3 Joseph, J-O-S-E-P-H.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Joseph.
5 ANC-2F does have standing as a protestant.

6 The protest issues in this matter are
7 adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet, and
8 residential parking and vehicular and pedestrian
9 safety. We need to set a date for mediation, the
10 status hearing, and the protesting hearing. I'll
11 give you the dates for the status and protest
12 hearing first. The status hearing is set for
13 July 13, 2022 at 10:30 a.m. That's July 13.

14 The protest hearing is set for August
15 10, 2022, at 1:30. I will give you the next date
16 available for mediation. The next available date
17 for mediation is Wednesday, June 22, anytime
18 between 10:00 and 1:30. That's the next
19 available day. Is that good?

20 MS. YOHANNES: I'm not available on
21 that day.

22 MS. FLETCHER: What about Thursday
23 June 23?

24 MS. YOHANNES: I can be available
25 after 12:30 if that works.

MS. FLETCHER: Let's move to the 30th.

MS. YOHANNES: Okay.

MS. FLETCHER: What about Thursday June 30, anytime between 9:00 and 1:30?

MS. YOHANNES: That works for me.

MS. FLETCHER: How about you, Ms. Joseph?

1 MS. JOSEPH: Could we do -- could we
2 do 12:00?

3 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. That's good on
4 this end.

5 What about you, Ms. Yohannes?

6 MS. YOHANNES: That works.

7 MS. JOSEPH: Thank you.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Mediation is scheduled
9 for Thursday, June 30, at 12:00 noon. I will
10 send you the WebEx invitation to attend.

11 MS. YOHANNES: Great.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
13 The roll call hearing the matter of The Springs
14 is concluded. Thank you.

15 MS. JOSEPH: Thank you.

16 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.
