Fletcher. My name is Matthew Minora from the law
firm of Mallios O'Brien & Sandground, ABC license
counsel for DC Rabbit Hole and Jon Liu, one of
the owners, is also on the call.

18	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
19	ANC 1B does have standing as a protestant. We
20	need to set a couple of dates now. We're going
21	to set a date for mediation, a status hearing,
22	and a protest hearing. I will give you the date
23	for the status and protest hearing first. The
24	day for the status hearing is going to be June 30
25	at 10:30 a.m., June 30 at 10:30 a.m. for the

status hearing. Also, if you're not -- if this is not your case, could you please mute yourself, please? I hear some noise in the background. Thank you.

The date for the protest hearing is May 11 -- I'm sorry -- August 11, 2021 at 1:30 p.m. is the day for the protest hearing.

We need to set a date for a mediation.

I'm going to disappear for one moment. I don't

have the correct calendar for mediation, so I'll

be right back. Just a second.

(Pause.)

MS. FLETCHER: I'm back. Okay. I've got my calendar now. I'll tell you the next date available for mediation. The next day available for mediation is June 22nd. That's next Tuesday at 9:10, 11:00, 1:00, or 2:00 in the afternoon. Pretty much anytime up until 2:00 actually on Tuesday, June 22nd. Does that day work for you, Mr. Minora?

MR. MINORA: I believe so. If we can do either 11:00 or later on in the day, that would be preferred.
