11 Who is present on behalf of the
12 applicant?

13 MR. LEE: Hi, Ms. Fletcher. This is
14 Kevin Lee, K-E-V-I-N, L-E-E. I'm attorney for
15 Union Liquor 2012.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Lee. Is
17 the applicant present?

18 MR. LEE: No. He is not so I
19 ***10:11:14.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you. Is
21 anyone present on behalf of ANC 8A?

22 (Pause/speaker muted.)

23 MS. WHITE: Sorry, I was talking and
24 didn't realize I was on mute. Good morning,
25 everyone. Hi, Ms. Fletcher.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Hi, Ms. White.

2 MS. WHITE: It's nice to see you all.

5 before 11:00.

7 would you like to do something at 1:00 or the
8 next day?

9 MR. LEE: How about the 21st (sic)
10 available, Thursday?

11 MS. FLETCHER: The 21st?

12 MR. LEE: The 24th.

13 MS. FLETCHER: The 24th?

14 MR. LEE: Yes.

15 MS. FLETCHER: The 24th of June,
16 that's a Thursday. Yes, that's available.
