The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met via WebEx videoconference, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson presiding.

3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case	
4	on our calendar is Case No. 20-CC-00085, Tenley	
5	Wine and Liquor License No. 78014. Ms. Andrews,	
6	can you please elevate the rights of the parties	
7	in this case please?	
8	MS. ANDREWS: Sure, stand by. Mr.	
9	Chair, Ms. Krupke is the only party for this.	
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No, there's,	
11	Ms. Krupke, have you spoken to the licensee?	
12	MS. KRUPKE: Yes, I have. She was	
13	going to appear today. She did have some trouble	
14	logging in. I last spoke with her about an hour	
15	ago so now actually at this point, it's now been	
16	about two hours.	
17	But, so I had hoped that she's been	
18	able to log in, but obviously I can't	
19	MS. ANDREWS: I'm sorry to interrupt.	
20	She is a call in, Mr. Chair. That's why I didn't	
21	see her name. I'm going to go ahead and add her.	
22	MS. SANGAR: Ms. Karin Sangar.	
23	MS. ANDREWS: Okay. That's all, Mr.	
24	Chair.	
25	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.	

Thank you. Hold on. All right, so Ms. Krupke, 1 2 can you please again spell and state your name 3 for the record please. MS. KRUPKE: Yes. This is Jessica 4 Krupke on behalf of the District of Columbia. 5 name is Jessica, J-E-S-S-I-C-A, last name Krupke, 6 7 K-R-U-P-K-E. 8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And if you're 9 here for Ms. Sangar, can you please spell and 10 state your name for the record, please? 11 MS. SANGAR: S-A-N-G-A-R. 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What is your 13 first name and last name please and what's your 14 relationship to the establishment, ma'am? 15 MS. SANGAR: First name is Kiran, K-I-16 R-A-N, last name Sangar, S-A-N-G-A-R. 17 relationship, I am the owner, operator for Tenley 18 Wine and Liquor. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 20 Thank you. Ms. Krupke, this is a show cause 21 hearing in the show cause status. Are there any 22 preliminary matters in this case please? 23 MS. KRUPKE: Yes. The parties have 24 reached an Offer and Compromise to present for 25 the Board's consideration today. There are two

charges in this matter.

The first is that the establishment sold to a minor under 21 years of age was the primary care violation. And a violation of DC Code 25-781.

The Offer and Compromise reached is that the fine would be \$3,000 payable within 60 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.

The second term is that the license shall be suspended for 10 days with four days to be served and six days stayed for one year. The days to be served would be this coming Sunday through Wednesday so that's June 20th through June 23rd.

And the third term of the Offer and Compromise for the first charge is that all employees who serve alcoholic beverages in a licensed establishment must complete an alcohol training program within three months from the day the Offer is accepted by the Board.

If it is indeed accepted. And then for Charge 2, the charge is failure to take reasonable steps necessary to ascertain the legal drinking age, a violation of BC Code 25-783, a

primary care violation.

And the Offer and Compromise is for \$2,000 payable within 60 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, thank you, Ms. Krupke. All right. Ms. Sangar, it's my understanding that there is an Offer and Compromise and the Offer and Compromise for Charge 1 is a \$3,000 fine payable in 60 days or the license will be suspended for 10 days, six days stayed and four days served.

All employees that serve alcoholic beverages to underage or all employees who serve alcoholic beverages will participate in training within three months.

For Charge 2, there is a fine of \$2,000 payable within 60 days. If the fine is not payable within 60 days, the license will be suspended and that the establishment will be closed June 20th, in essence closed and prevented from selling alcohol and from June 20th through June 23rd, 2021.

Is this your understanding, ma'am, of the Offer and Compromise?

MS. SANGAR: Yes, it is.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware that by accepting an Offer and Compromise, that you're giving up your right to a hearing?

MS. SANGAR: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also aware that by accepting an Offer and Compromise that you're giving up your right to appeal this matter?

MS. SANGAR: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are there any questions by any Board Members regarding this Offer and Compromise?

Hearing none, I make a motion that the Offer and Compromise for Charge 1 which is a fine of \$3,000 payable in 60 days be accepted, that the license will be suspended for 10 days, six days stayed and four served.

The four days that will be served are June 20th through June 23rd, 2021. That all employees that serve alcoholic beverages that they undergo training within three months.

The Charge 2 that there's a fine of \$2,000 payable in 60 days and if the fine is not payable in 60 days, the license will be suspended

until the fine has been paid. 1 2 I make a motion that this be accepted. 3 Is there a second? 4 MR. CATO: Bobby Cato seconds. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato will 5 second the motion. We will now have a roll call 6 7 vote of the motion. Mr. Short? 8 MR. SHORT: Mr. Short. I agree. 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato? 10 MR. CATO: Bobby Cato. I agree. 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett? 12 MS. CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett. 13 agree. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen? 15 MS. HANSEN: Jeni Hansen. I agree. 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis? 17 MR. GRANDIS: Edward Grandis. Ι 18 agree. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I am Mr. 20 I agree. The matter passed six, zero, Anderson. 21 I want to thank the parties for agreeing 22 to this Offer and Compromise and I just want to 23 again let the Licensee know that during the 24 period of suspension, which is June 22nd through 25 June 23rd, your establishment is prohibited from

1	selling or serving alcohol during that period of		
2	time.		
3	Is that, do you understand, ma'am,		
4	that you cannot sell alcohol. Let me see, you		
5	are a liquor store so you can't serve, but so you		
6	are aware that during this period of time you		
7	cannot sell any alcoholic beverages. Are you		
8	clear with that, ma'am?		
9	MS. SANGAR: Yes.
