3 MS. FLETCHER: Good morning, everyone.

4 We are now live streaming to YouTube. Thank you
5 for participating in ABRA's roll call hearings
6 via the WebEx platform provided by the D.C.
7 Office of Open Government. There are four cases
8 on the calendar today.

9 The first case on the calendar is
10 Foxtrot, which is case no. 22-PRO-00043, Foxtrot
11 Retail DC, LLC. 1341 14th Street NW. License
12 no. ABRA-120197. This is a Retailer Class B, new
13 application. The protest issues are adverse
14 impact on peace, order, and quiet. My name is
15 Laverne Fletcher, conducting the roll call
16 hearing as the Board's agent. Is anyone present
17 on behalf of Foxtrot?

18 MS. YOHANNES: Yes. Sidon Yohannes.
19 I am here on behalf of Foxtrot. And that is S-I-
20 D-O-N, Y-O-H-A-N-N-E-S.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Anyone
22 present on behalf of ANC 2F?

23 MS. YAN: Hi, yes. This is
24 Commissioner Michelle Yan. I am the commissioner
25 for 2F03 where Foxtrot is seeking their license.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Michelle, would you
2 please spell your name for the record.

3 MS. YAN: Absolutely. It's M-I-C-H-E-
4 L-L-E. Last name is Yan, Y-A-N.

5 MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Yan, will you be
6 representing ANC 2F throughout these proceedings?

7 MS. YAN: Yes.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. We don't have an
9 email address for you. Would you like to give me
10 that now?

11 MS. YAN: Yes. It's 2f03@anc.dc.gov.

12 MS. FLETCHER: So that's
13 2f03@anc.dc.gov?

14 MS. YAN: .dc. Correct.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.
16 Okay. Well, thank you for that. ANC 2F does
17 have standing as a protestant. I'm going to give
18 you some dates for a status hearing and a protest
19 hearing. And then we'll set a date for
20 mediation. The status hearing is scheduled for
21 July 20. July 20 at 10:30 a.m. for the status
22 hearing. The protest hearing is set for August
23 10. August 10 at 1:30. It's August 10, 2022, at
24 1:30 for the status hearing.

25 MS. YOHANNES: The protest hearing.

1 MS. FLETCHER: The protest hearing.
2 Thank you. Protest hearing August 10, 2022, at
3 1:30. Thank you. I'm gong to give you the next
4 available day for mediation. Let's see. The
5 next available day for mediation is Tuesday, oh.
6 We have a holiday. I have the wrong calendar.
7 So we're closed on July 4. One second. I don't
8 have a holiday calendar, but I just remembered
9 that July 4 is a holiday. So the next available
10 day is actually going to be Tuesday, July 5, at
11 11:30.

12 MS. YOHANNES: I would request, if the
13 ANC's fine with that, the following week and
14 maybe towards the end of that week. I hope that,
15 by that time, the parties can come to a
16 resolution.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Then what about
18 Thursday, July 14?

19 MS. YOHANNES: That would work for us.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Would that work for
21 you, Ms. Yan?

22 MS. YAN: I'm going to be out of
23 office on the 14th and 15th. If it's possible to
24 do the 13th at all, that would be great.
25 Otherwise, I can try to make the 14th work.

1 MS. FLETCHER: The 13th is available.

2 MS. YAN: Sidon, does that work on
3 your end?

4 MS. YOHANNES: Sorry. In the
5 afternoon.

6 MS. FLETCHER: We could do the 13th at
7 1:30.

8 MS. YOHANNES: Yes. That would work.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Would that work for
10 you, Ms. Yan?

11 MS. YAN: Yes. Thank you.

12 MS. YOHANNES: So the 13th at 1:30.

13 MS. FLETCHER: And that's for the
14 Class B mediation. Okay. So mediation is set
15 for Wednesday, July 13, at 1:30. And you'll
16 receive a WebEx invitation from me for the
17 mediation.

18 MS. YOHANNES: Thank you.

19 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.

20 MS. YAN: Great. Thank you.

21 MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.

22 Any questions at all?

23 MS. YOHANNES: No. But, no.

24 MS. YAN: None on my end.

25 MS. FLETCHER: What was that? Ms.

1 Yan, did you say something?

2 MS. YAN: I said no questions on my
3 end.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.
5 Well, thank you for coming. The matter of
6 Foxtrot related to the Class B license
7 application is concluded.
