3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the
4 calendar is Georgetown Restaurant Group, LLC,
5 trading as To Be Determined. This is Case No.
6 22-PRO-00045. 3276 M Street NW, License No.
7 ABRA-120570. This is a Retailer Class CR, new
8 application. The protest issues are adverse
9 impact on peace, order, and quiet. My name is
10 Laverne Fletcher, conducting the roll call
11 hearing as the Board's agent. Is anyone present
12 on behalf of the establishment?

13 MS. MAHMOUD: Hi. Good morning, Ms.
14 Fletcher, this is Manalle Mahmoud with Mallios
15 O'Brien & Sandground, on behalf of Georgietown
16 Restaurant Group. M-A-N-A-L-L-E, M-A-H-M-O-U-D.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Mahmoud.
18 Is anyone present on behalf of ANC 2E?

19 MR. SACCO: This is Peter Sacco. I'm
20 the executive director for ANC 2E. That's S-A-C-
21 C-O.

22 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Sacco, are you
23 going to be representing ANC 2E throughout this
24 proceeding?

25 MR. SACCO: I will not. It will be

1 Commissioner Lisa Palmer, who is the commissioner
2 for the district that the establishment is in.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you. And
4 so what I'll do, I will send the Webex invitation
5 for mediation to Ms. Palmer.

6 MR. SACCO: That would be great.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So then we'll
8 just keep her listed as the designated
9 representative.

10 MR. SACCO: Yes, please.

11 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So we're making
12 a note, of course, that you were present today,
13 but going forward we should send the invitations
14 to Lisa Palmer.

15 MR. SACCO: That would be great. Yes,
16 thank you.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you. ANC
18 2E does have standing as a protestant. We need
19 to set a date for mediation, a status hearing,
20 and a protest hearing. I'll give you the dates
21 for the status and protest hearing first. The
22 status hearing is set for July 20. July 20,
23 2022, at 10:30. That's for the status hearing.
24 The protest hearing is set for August 10, 2022,
25 at 1:30. That's the protest hearing.

1 I'll give you the next available day
2 for mediation. The next available day is
3 Tuesday, July the 5th. Ms. Mahmoud, is that a
4 good day for you?

5 MS. MAHMOUD: Ms. Fletcher, if
6 possible, can we push it to the following week?
7 Matt Minora, my colleague, is actually going to
8 attend the mediation, and he's out of office
9 until the 5th.

10 MS. FLETCHER: What about Tuesday,
11 July 12th?

12 MS. MAHMOUD: That's wonderful, thank
13 you.

14 MS. FLETCHER: All right. You prefer
15 afternoon?

16 MS. MAHMOUD: Yes, please.

17 MS. FLETCHER: 1:30?

18 MS. MAHMOUD: That's great. Thank you
19 so much.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Sacco, so you're
21 going to run that date by Lisa Palmer?

22 MR. SACCO: I will. I'll just pass it
23 along. And if there are any issues, I'm sure
24 she'll email both of you.

25 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. Thank you.

1 Mediation is set for Tuesday, July 12, at 1:30.

2 Ms. Mahmoud, so should I send the Webex
3 invitation for mediation to you and Mr. Minora?

4 MS. MAHMOUD: Yes, please.

5 MS. FLETCHER: I will do that. Okay.
6 Any questions, anybody?

7 MS. MAHMOUD: No, thank you so much.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Well, thank you very
9 much for coming. I'll see you soon.

10 MS. MAHMOUD: Yes.

11 MR. SACCO: Thank you.

12 MS. MAHMOUD: Take care.

13 MS. FLETCHER: All right. The roll
14 call hearing in this matter is concluded.
