3 MS. FLETCHER: I am calling the matter  
4 of O'Connor's Liquors. O'Connor's is spelled O-  
5 C-O-N-N-O-R-S. O'Connor's Liquor, Inc., 2900  
6 Minnesota Avenue Southeast, License Number ABRA-  
7 060231.

8 This is a Retailer Class A license  
9 renewal. The protest issues are adverse impact  
10 on peace, order, and quiet. My name is LaVerne  
11 Fletcher, conducting the roll call hearing as the  
12 Board's agent.

13 Is the Applicant present?

14 MR. AHN: Yes.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.  
16 Would you please state your name and spell it for  
17 the record?

18 MR. AHN: First name is B-Y-O-U-N-G,  
19 and last name is A-H-N.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.  
21 Is there anyone else present with you today?

22 MR. LEE: I'm -- I'm his brother-in-  
23 law and an employee. And my name is Bruce, B-R-  
24 U-C-E. Last name is Lee, L-E-E.

25 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Lee.

1 And so you're present in support of your brother-  
2 in-law?

3 MR. LEE: Yes.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Just want to  
5 make sure you're not an Applicant. Okay. Well,  
6 thank you very much.

7 And present on behalf of ANC 7B?

8 MS. BROWN: Hello. It's Tiffany L.  
9 Brown, Chair of ANC 7B. My name is spelled T-I-  
10 F-F-A-N-Y, middle initial L, last name Brown, B-  
11 R-O-W-N.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Brown.  
13 Glad you got through.

14 MS. BROWN: So am I.

15 MS. FLETCHER: I was about to send an  
16 invitation, but I see you were sent one.

17 MS. BROWN: Yes.

18 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you  
19 for coming.

20 ANC 7B does have standing as a  
21 protestor. We need to set a date for a  
22 mediation, a status hearing, and a protest  
23 hearing if that date is available today. Give me  
24 one second, please. Just a second.

25 MS. BROWN: I have my camera off so I

1 can look at my calendar.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

3 (Pause.)

4 MS. FLETCHER: The status hearing is  
5 scheduled for July 15 at 10:30 a.m.

6 MR. LEE: is an earlier date  
7 available?

8 MS. FLETCHER: That's the next  
9 available day on the Board's calendar.

10 MR. LEE: No, I'm talking about time.

11 MS. FLETCHER: The time --

12 (Simultaneous speaking.)

13 MS. FLETCHER: 10:30 a.m. So -- so  
14 that's the time of the status hearing. So who is  
15 --

16 MS. BROWN: That time is --

17 (Simultaneous speaking.)

18 MS. BROWN: -- for me.

19 MS. FLETCHER: Well, it's -- it's the  
20 only time there is.

21 MS. BROWN: Okay.

22 MS. FLETCHER: So all status hearings  
23 are set at the same time. So all of the status  
24 hearings for that day except for July 15 at 10:30  
25 a.m. -- so it may not be at exactly 10:30.

1 MR. LEE: Okay.

2 MS. FLETCHER: But who's -- who's not  
3 available at 10:30? Mr. -- Mr. Ahn, are you  
4 available at 10:30?

5 MR. AHN: That's -- that's good.

6 (Simultaneous speaking.)

7 MS. FLETCHER: So -- so, Mr. Lee, it  
8 may not be at exactly 10:30, but they're just all  
9 set for 10:30. They don't take very long.

10 MR. LEE: Okay. Okay.

11 MS. FLETCHER: So it's --

12 (Simultaneous speaking.)

13 MS. FLETCHER: -- your case is called.

14 MR. LEE: Okay. That's fine.

15 MS. FLETCHER: At the -- at the status  
16 hearing, the Board only wants to know the status  
17 of the case.

18 MR. LEE: Okay.

19 MS. FLETCHER: That's all they want to  
20 know at that stage. If -- if there has been a  
21 mediation, you would report that there's been a  
22 mediation and whether or not the case was settled  
23 in mediation or not. That's it.

24 MR. LEE: All right. Thank you.

25 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.

1 I will give you the next available day  
2 for mediation. The next available day for  
3 mediation is Friday, July the 2nd. But if that's  
4 too close to the holiday, we can do it on  
5 Thursday, July 8, or Friday, July 9.

6 (Simultaneous speaking.)

7 MR. AHN: Thursday, July 8, is good.

8 MS. FLETCHER: The 2nd is good?

9 MS. BROWN: Let me go back to my  
10 calendar to look at the 8th.

11 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

12 Mr. Ahn, do you have a preference for  
13 July 8 or 9?

14 MR. AHN: 8 is better.

15 MS. FLETCHER: July 8 is better?  
16 Okay.

17 MS. BROWN: That's fine as long as  
18 it's in the morning. But I think I'm going to  
19 have to hop off now.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Well, what about --

21 MS. BROWN: The 8th is fine as long as  
22 it's --

23 (Simultaneous speaking.)

24 MS. FLETCHER: The 8th is fine? What  
25 about 10:00 in the morning of the 8th?

1 MS. BROWN: 10:00 is good.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Is that good for you,  
3 Mr. Ahn?

4 MR. AHN: Yes.

5 MS. FLETCHER: The mediation is set  
6 for -- mediation is set for Thursday, July 8, at  
7 10:00 a.m.

8 MR. AHN: Thank you.

9 MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.  
10 Any questions about that?

11 MR. LEE: If Ms. Brown and Mr. Ahn  
12 agreed upon the -- whatever the miscommunication,  
13 then everything should be okay; we don't need to  
14 show up for the mediation, right?

15 MS. FLETCHER: Yes, Mr. Lee. That is  
16 correct. If the matter can be resolved between  
17 the parties prior to mediation, you can let me  
18 know and the mediation would be canceled.

19 MR. LEE: Okay. All right. Okay.  
20 Thank you.

21 And, Ms. Brown, Mr. Ahn would like to  
22 have a little -- is it possible you could give us  
23 a phone number or email address so we could  
24 contact you?

25 MS. BROWN: Ms. Fletcher, can you give

1 him the email address? I can hardly speak.

2 MS. FLETCHER: I -- I will.

3 MS. BROWN: Okay. Thank you.

4 MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.

5 Mr. Ahn?

6 MR. AHN: Yeah.

7 MS. FLETCHER: I will give you Ms.

8 Brown's email address. I'll send it to you.

9 MR. AHN: Okay. Thank you.

10 MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.

11 One second. I'm going to email it to you. Just  
12 making a note. One second.

13 (Pause.)

14 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Lee, I have a  
15 question for you.

16 MR. LEE: Sure.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Are -- are you going to  
18 be participating in the mediation, if there is  
19 one, for Mr. Ahn?

20 MR. LEE: Yes. I'll be -- basically,  
21 because of -- his language is sometimes limited.  
22 So I'm going to help him out with that part, too.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Okay --

24 (Simultaneous speaking.)

25 MR. LEE: -- what's going on.



1 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. That's fine.

2 And you know, Mr. Ahn, you also have  
3 the option of requesting an interpreter from us.  
4 But if you're good with Mr. Lee speaking on your  
5 behalf, that's fine with us.

6 MR. AHN: Thank you.

7 MS. FLETCHER: So you're okay with  
8 that, Mr. Ahn?

9 MR. AHN: Yeah. Yeah.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.  
11 Okay. I just made a note of that.

12 And so Ms. Brown?

13 (Pause.)

14 MS. FLETCHER: Well, I was only going  
15 to let Ms. Brown know that she would be  
16 communicating with Mr. Lee as well. But I'm sure  
17 she knows that already.

18 Any questions at all?

19 MR. LEE: Oh, that's it. Any  
20 question?

21 MR. AHN: No.

22 MR. LEE: Okay.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you  
24 for coming.

25 MR. LEE: Thank you.

1 (Simultaneous speaking.)

2 MS. FLETCHER: I'll see you soon.

3 MR. LEE: Okay. Thank you.

4 MS. FLETCHER: If the matter's  
5 resolved, I won't see you.

6 MR. LEE: Okay. Thank you.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. All right. Take  
8 care. Signing off. Okay. Bye-bye. Thank you,  
9 everyone.

10 (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter  
11 went off the record at 11:19 a.m.)
