3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
4 we are on the record. Good morning. As
5 chairperson of the Alcoholic Beverage and
6 Cannabis Board for the District of Columbia and
7 in accordance with DC Code Section 2571 et. seq.
8 of the Open Meetings Act, OMA, I'm welcoming you
9 to the regular scheduled meeting of the Alcoholic
10 Beverage and Cannabis Board.

11 This meeting's being conducted
12 pursuant to guidance made available by the
13 District of Columbia's Office of Open Government
14 regarding electronic meetings held by public
15 bodies. Electronic meetings by the ABC Board are
16 authorized pursuant to Section 2577(a) of the DC
17 Code. Pursuant to the OMA requirements, notice

19 advance of the meeting on ABCA's website and on
20 the District's central meeting calendar.

4 chairperson of the Board. I want to introduce
5 the other members of the ABC Board who are also
6 participating electronically. Please respond

12 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Silas Grant,

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The Board has
15 three members in attendance for the conduct of
16 business today, and that constitutes a quorum.
17 Before we get underway with today's hearing
18 calendar, I need to make a few instructions very
19 clear so that the conduct of these hearings is
20 understood by everyone.

21 There are seven cases on this
22 morning's calendar. Once your case is called, I
23 will take a moment for IT specialist to elevate
24 the rights for each party to enable their camera
25 and microphone. Then and only then, will you

1 have the ability to enable your equipment. If
2 your case is not being heard, you will remain
3 mute and your camera will be disabled.
