MS. FLETCHER: ANC 6E does have standing as a protestant. We need to set a date for mediation, status hearing, and the protest hearing. I will give you the date for the status and book this hearing first. The status hearing is set for August 3, 2022 at 10:30. That's August 3, 2022 at 10:30. The protest hearing is set for September 21, September 21, 2022, at 1:30.

I'll give you the next available day for mediation. The next available day is -- so there are a couple of things. We can do it on Thursday, July 14 or Monday, July 18. On the 14th, we can have the mediation anytime between 10 and 1:30, and on Monday the 18th 1:30 only.
