3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the
4 calendar is Thompson Washington D.C. Anchovy.
5 This is Case Number 22-PRO-00049; Third and
6 Tingey Hotel Owner, LLC; 221 Tingey Street,
7 Southeast; License Number ABRA-114613. This is a
8 Retailer Class CH license renewal.

9 Excuse me one second, please. One
10 second. The protest issues are adverse impact on
11 peace, order, and quiet.

12 My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting
13 the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Is
14 anyone present on behalf of Tingey Hotel?

15 MS. YOHANNES: Yes, Sidon Yohannes on
16 behalf, here on behalf of the licensee. That's

14 MS. FLETCHER: 10 a.m. works?

15 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. In that case,
17 one second. Mediation is scheduled for, excuse
18 me, Thursday, July 14 at 10. I will send the
19 WebEx invitations out, and I will see you then.

20 MS. YOHANNES: Thank you.

21 MR. DANIELS: Great. Thank you so much.
