3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the
4 calendar is Causa. This is Case Number 22-PRO-
5 00051; Causa, LLC; 920 N Street, Northwest;
6 License Number ABRA-114552. This is a Retailer
7 Class CR license renewal. The protest issues are
8 adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet;
9 residential parking; and vehicular and pedestrian
10 safety; real property values; and
11 overconcentration.

12 Is anyone present on behalf of Causa?

13 MR. SPANGLER: I am. Chad Spangler,
14 C-H-A-D, S-P-A-N-G-L-E-R.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Chad Spangler. Thank
16 you, Mr. Spangler. Is anyone present on behalf

13 hearing is August 3. What about Tuesday, July
14 19, anytime between 10 and 1:30?

19 MS. FLETCHER: So, Mr. Spangler, 10:00
