The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board  
met via WebEx videoconference, LaVerne Fletcher,  
Board's Agent, presiding.

3 MS. FLETCHER: The last case on the  
4 calendar is Surfside. This is Case Number 22-  
5 PRO-00052; Scribone LLC; 4200 Wisconsin Avenue,  
6 Northwest; License Number ABRA-113253. This is a  
7 Retailer Class CR license renewal. The protest  
8 issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and  
9 quiet; and residential parking; and vehicular and  
10 pedestrian safety.

11 My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting  
12 the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Is  
13 anyone present on behalf of the applicant?

14 MS. YOHANNES: Yes. Sidon Yohannes  
15 here on behalf of the licensee, applicant. S-I-  
16 D-O-N, Y-O-H-A-N-N-E-S.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms.  
18 Yohannes. And on behalf of ANC 3E?

19 MS. GIANINNO: Alexandria Gianinno.  
20 That's A-L-E-X-A-N-D-R-I-A, Gianinno, G-I-A-N-I-  
21 N-N-O.

22 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. G-I-A-N --

23 MS. GIANINNO: N-I-N-N-O. Sorry.  
24 It's complicated.

25 MS. FLETCHER: I'm trying to get all

1 my Ns down here. Just one second.

2 MS. GIANINNO: Just one and then two.

3 MS. FLETCHER: One and then two. G-I-  
4 A -- okay. I have it. G-I-A-N-I-N-N-O.

5 MS. GIANINNO: Correct.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Gianinno, are you  
7 going to be representing ANC 3E throughout these  
8 proceedings?

9 MS. GIANINNO: I am.

10 MS. FLETCHER: I believe -- give me  
11 one second. I believe that I have your email  
12 address; I just want to make sure. Give me one  
13 minute. Okay. Actually, I don't see it right  
14 now, but what is it?

15 MS. GIANINNO: It's 3E05@anc.dc.gov.

16 MS. FLETCHER: At anc.dc.gov?

17 MS. GIANINNO: I believe that it's dot  
18 gov, yes. I don't say it out loud very often.  
19 Sorry.

20 MS. FLETCHER: I have 3E05@anc.dc.gov.

21 MS. GIANINNO: Yes, or I can give you  
22 a gmail one, if it's easier, in case I just  
23 messed up the dot org or the dot gov.

24 MS. FLETCHER: No, that's good.

25 MS. GIANINNO: Okay.

1 MS. FLETCHER: ANC 3E does have  
2 standing as a protestant.

3 We need to set a date for a status  
4 hearing, protest hearing, and mediation. I'll  
5 give you the date for the status and protest  
6 hearings first.

7 The status hearing is scheduled for  
8 August the 3rd, 2022 at 10:30. The protest  
9 hearing is set for September 21 at 1:30.

10 I will give you the next available day  
11 for mediation, which is Friday, July 15 is the  
12 next available day; or if that doesn't work, we  
13 can move to the next week.

14 MS. YOHANNES: Can we please move to  
15 the next week? I'm not available.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. What about, so  
17 Wednesday, the 20th, is available. Ms. Yohannes,  
18 do you have any other cases on the calendar for  
19 Wednesday; do you know?

20 MS. YOHANNES: I don't believe I have  
21 any protest hearings, but I have things in the  
22 morning.

23 MS. FLETCHER: If you want to, we can  
24 do Thursday or Friday. Thursday is the 21st,  
25 Friday is the 22nd.

1 MS. GIANINNO: Can you do the 21st?

2 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

3 MS. FLETCHER: 21st is good for you,  
4 Ms. Gianinno?

5 MS. GIANINNO: Gianinno.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Gianinno? I'm  
7 having a hard time with names today. Okay. So  
8 was that the 21st that's good?

9 MS. YOHANNES: That's great for me, if  
10 that works for you.

11 MS. GIANINNO: Same.

12 MS. YOHANNES: Do you have a  
13 preference for time? Any time between 10 and  
14 1:30.

15 MS. GIANINNO: Could we do the earlier  
16 side? Does that work for you, Sidon?

17 MS. YOHANNES: That's fine.

18 MS. GIANINNO: Okay.

19 MS. FLETCHER: It's set for Thursday,  
20 July 21st at 10.

21 MS. GIANINNO: Perfect. And if  
22 there's a way that we can have conversations  
23 before then, I'm really open to having  
24 conversations before we get to this so that we  
25 don't necessarily need to move forward formally.

1 MS. YOHANNES: Absolutely. I will  
2 send you an email after this so that you have my  
3 contact information.

4 MS. GIANINNO: Perfect.

5 MS. YOHANNES: Thank you.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, maybe I'll  
7 see you then, maybe I won't. Okay. Well, thank  
8 you for coming.

9 MS. GIANINNO: Thank you.

10 MS. YOHANNES: Thank you.

11 MS. FLETCHER: The roll call hearing  
12 is concluded. Thank you.

13 MS. YOHANNES: Have a great day.

14 MS. FLETCHER: You, too.
