3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We now move to
4	our Show Cause Hearing Status Calendar. The
5	first case on that calendar is Case No. 23-251-
6	00003, Air Restaurant, License No. 117404.
7	Mr. Orellana, can you please elevate
8	the rights of the Government and the Licensee in
9	this case.
10	MR. ORELLANA: Mr. Cameron Mixon, your
11	access has been elevated. And Mr. Chris
12	Southcott, your access has been elevated.
13	That is all Chairman.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
15	Good morning Mr. Southcott. Can you
16	please identify yourself for the record.
17	MR. SOUTHCOTT: My name is Chris
18	Southcott, first name C-H-R-I-S, last name S-O-U-
19	T-H-C-O-T-T from D.C. Office of the Attorney
20	General.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Mixon,
22	please identify yourself for the record.
23	MR. MIXON: Hello. Cameron Mixon,
24	first name C-A-M-E-R-O-N, last name Mixon, M-I-X-
25	O-N, counsel to the licensee.

2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
3	sir.
4	Mr. Southcott, are there any
5	preliminary matters in this case?
6	MR. SOUTHCOTT: I believe that the
7	parties have reached an Offer in Compromise.
8	That's what my colleague communicated to me. My
9	understanding is that we will be reading the
10	terms of the OIC into the record.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Mixon, is
12	that correct from your perspective?
13	MR. MIXON: That's correct. I
14	extended the Licensee's acceptance yesterday.
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Southcott,
16	what is the Offer in Compromise?
17	MR. SOUTHCOTT: There is one charge.
18	The establishment was used for an unlawful
19	purpose in violation of D.C. Code 25-823(a)(2).
20	It is a first primary tier violation and the OIC
21	is \$1,000 within 30 days or the license shall be
22	suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.
23	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
24	Mr. Mixon, it's my understanding there
25	is an Offer in Compromise and the Offer in

1 Compromise is that there is a fine of \$1,000 2 payable within 30 days of the. The license will be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been 3 4 paid. 5 Is this your client's understanding, sir, of the Offer in Compromise? 6 7 MR. SOUTHCOTT: It is. 8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client 9 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise 10 they give up their right to a hearing? 11 He does. MR. SOUTHCOTT: 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client 13 also aware that by accepting an Offer in 14 Compromise that they give up their right to 15 appeal this matter? 16 MR. SOUTHCOTT: They do. 17 Thank you. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Any 18 questions by any Board Members? Hearing none, I 19 then make a motion that the Offer in Compromise 20 be accepted as a fine of \$1,000 payable within 30 21 If the fine has not been paid within 30 22 days, the license will be suspended indefinitely 23 until the fine has been paid. 24 Is there a second? 25 MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis will
