3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case that I'm
4 calling is Seymour's Liquors. This is Case No.
5 21-PRO-00039, Jackson Family Liquor Store Inc.,
6 5579 and 5581 Central Avenue, Southeast. License
7 No. ABRA-112303. This is a Retailer Class A
8 license renewal.

9 The protest issues are adverse impact
10 on peace, order, and quiet.

11 My name is LaVerne Fletcher,
12 conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's
13 agent.

14 Is the Applicant present in the matter
15 of Seymour's Liquors? Is anyone present on
16 behalf of Seymour's Liquors?

17 (No response.)

18 Is anyone present on behalf of ANC 7E?

19 MS. MARTIN: My name is Kimberly
20 Martin. I'm on behalf of ANC 7E.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you, Ms.
22 Martin.

23 Could you please spell your name for
24 the record?

25 MS. MARTIN: Kimberly,

1 K-I-M-B-E-R-L-Y; last name, Martin, M-A-R-T-I-N.

2 MS. FLETCHER: ANC 7E does have
3 standing as a Protestant.

4 We need to set a date for a mediation
5 status hearing and protest hearing.

6 But, Ms. Martin, we cannot actually do
7 that until the Applicant is here.

8 MS. MARTIN: Yes, I understand.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. I'm just giving
10 him an opportunity to identify himself, if he's
11 on the line.

12 (Pause.)

13 The time is approximately 10:15, and
14 the Applicant is not present. Therefore, the
15 application to renew the license is dismissed.

16 Ms. Martin, what that means is that
17 the Applicant will receive a Board Order, and
18 you'll receive a copy of an Order dismissing the
19 license renewal application.

20 Upon receipt of the Order, the
21 Applicant will have 10 days to seek the
22 reinstatement of his application, explaining to
23 the ABC Board why he or she was not present
24 today.

25 You'll receive a copy of the Order.

1 And if the Applicant seeks reinstatement, you'll
2 have an opportunity to respond.

3 MS. MARTIN: Okay. Thank you.

4 MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.

5 And, Ms. Martin, are you here for the
6 matter of -- oh, never mind. Disregard.

7 MS. MARTIN: Okay.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you
9 for coming.

10 MS. MARTIN: Yes. Thank you.

11 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. You're welcome.

12 The roll call hearing is concluded.

13 (Whereupon, at 10:16 a.m. the roll
14 call hearing was concluded.)
