The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met via WebEx videoconference, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson presiding.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We're now at the end of our morning calendar and so therefore I will now do our legal agenda.

The first matter on our legal agenda, and as $I$ stated before, Ms. Hansen is participating in our hearings today. When I call for a roll call vote, she will write her vote in the chat, and $I$ will count her vote for the final vote count.

The first case number on our legal agenda is a review of an offer in compromise in lieu of a hearing dated June 28, 2022 for Case \# 22-CMP 00024 and 22-251-00011, DC Shenanigans, license \#088119.

The Offer in Compromise is as follows. This is for Case \# 22-251-00011. Charge one, allow the establishment to be used for lawful purpose. This the second primary tier violation within two years. Statutory authority DC Code section 25-82382. There will be a fine of \$2,000 to be paid within 120 days or the license will be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Charge two, failed to follow security plan. Again, second primary tier violation within two years. Statutory authority DC Code section 25-82386. There is a $\$ 2,000$ fine payable within 120 days or the license will be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

For Case \# 22-CMP-00024, charge one, operating over occupancy, second primary tier violation within two years. Statutory authority DC Code section 25-762(d)(1). There will be a fine of $\$ 2,000$ to be paid within 120 days or the ABC license will be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Therefore, I make a motion that the ABC Board accepts this offer in compromise, is there a second?

Number two on our legal agenda is a review of an offer in compromise in lieu of a hearing dated June 28, 2022 for Case \# 21-CIT00006, Each Peach Market, license \#092449.

The offer in compromise is as follows. Charge one, sale of alcoholic beverages to minor, statutory authority DC Code section 25-781. There is a fine of $\$ 3,000$ payable within 60 days of the Board accepting the OID, and if payment is made within 60 days the license will be suspended until payment has been made. Additional terms, the license shall be suspended for 10 days with four days to be served from August 14 through August 17. The remaining six days stayed for one year. All employees who serve alcoholic
beverages in the licensed establishment must complete the alcohol training program within three months from the date of the OIC.

Charge two, failed to take reasonable steps necessary to ascertain legal drinking age. Statutory authority DC Code section 25-783. There is a fine of $\$ 2,000$ payable within 60 days of the Board accepting the offer in compromise, and if payment is made within 60 days the license will be suspended until payment is received.

I, therefore, make a motion that the ABC Board accepts this offer in compromise. Is there a second?
