3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We're now at
4 the end of our morning calendar and so therefore
5 I will now do our legal agenda.

6 The first matter on our legal agenda,
7 and as I stated before, Ms. Hansen is
8 participating in our hearings today. When I call
9 for a roll call vote, she will write her vote in
10 the chat, and I will count her vote for the final
11 vote count.

12 The first case number on our legal
13 agenda is a review of an offer in compromise in
14 lieu of a hearing dated June 28, 2022 for Case #
15 22-CMP 00024 and 22-251-00011, DC Shenanigans,
16 license #088119.

17 The Offer in Compromise is as follows.
18 This is for Case # 22-251-00011. Charge one,
19 allow the establishment to be used for lawful
20 purpose. This the second primary tier violation
21 within two years. Statutory authority DC Code
22 section 25-82382. There will be a fine of \$2,000
23 to be paid within 120 days or the license will be
24 suspended indefinitely until the fine has been
25 paid.

1 Charge two, failed to follow security
2 plan. Again, second primary tier violation
3 within two years. Statutory authority DC Code
4 section 25-82386. There is a \$2,000 fine payable
5 within 120 days or the license will be suspended
6 indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

7 For Case # 22-CMP-00024, charge one,
8 operating over occupancy, second primary tier
9 violation within two years. Statutory authority
10 DC Code section 25-762(d)(1). There will be a
11 fine of \$2,000 to be paid within 120 days or the
12 ABC license will be suspended indefinitely until
13 the fine has been paid.

14 Therefore, I make a motion that the
15 ABC Board accepts this offer in compromise, is
16 there a second?

17 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. I'll
18 second.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
20 seconded the motion. I will now take a roll call
21 vote. Mr. Short?

22 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. I agree.

11 Number two on our legal agenda is a
12 review of an offer in compromise in lieu of a
13 hearing dated June 28, 2022 for Case # 21-CIT-
14 00006, Each Peach Market, license #092449.

15 The offer in compromise is as follows.
16 Charge one, sale of alcoholic beverages to minor,
17 statutory authority DC Code section 25-781.
18 There is a fine of \$3,000 payable within 60 days
19 of the Board accepting the OID, and if payment is
20 made within 60 days the license will be suspended
21 until payment has been made. Additional terms,
22 the license shall be suspended for 10 days with
23 four days to be served from August 14 through
24 August 17. The remaining six days stayed for one
25 year. All employees who serve alcoholic

1 beverages in the licensed establishment must
2 complete the alcohol training program within
3 three months from the date of the OIC.

4 Charge two, failed to take reasonable
5 steps necessary to ascertain legal drinking age.
6 Statutory authority DC Code section 25-783.
7 There is a fine of \$2,000 payable within 60 days
8 of the Board accepting the offer in compromise,
9 and if payment is made within 60 days the license
10 will be suspended until payment is received.

11 I, therefore, make a motion that the
12 ABC Board accepts this offer in compromise. Is
13 there a second?

25 agree.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.
2 I agree. We didn't hear Mr. Grandis, but he
3 voted that he agreed. So, the matter passed 6-0-
4 0.

5 We are now at the end of our morning
6 calendar and our morning agenda. I would like to
7 thank all members of the public who participated
8 in our hearings this morning. The Board will now
9 adjourn for the morning. We will be back for our
10 1:30 afternoon session, and I would direct all
11 Board members to return to executive session for
12 further action. Have a great morning. Thank you
13 very much.
