CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning everyone. As chairperson of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for the District of Columbia and in accordance with D.C. The Board supports settlement agreements because when there is a settlement agreement it says that both parties are happy. If the Board has to make a determination, which we will, if we have to, then once side might be happy, and the
