4 next protest hearing status case is Case # 22-
5 PRO-00028, National Union Building, license
6 #120514. Ms. Fashbaugh, can you please elevate
7 the rights of the protestant in this case,
8 please.

9 MS. FASHBAUGH: Ashley Steinberg, your
10 rights have been elevated. That is all.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
12 everyone.

13 MS. STEINBERG: Good morning.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Yohannes,
15 can you please spell and state your name for the
16 record, please.

17 MS. YOHANNES: Sidon Yohannes on
18 behalf of the applicant. That's S-I-D-O-N Y-O-H-
19 A-N-N-E-S.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Yohannes,
21 will the applicant be participating in this
22 matter this morning, ma'am?

23 MS. YOHANNES: No, she will not.

24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. Ms.
25 Steinberg, can you please spell and state your

1 name for the record and your relationship to this
2 case.

3 MS. STEINBERG: Sure. Ashley
4 Steinberg, A-S-H-L-E-Y S-T-E-I-N-B-E-R-G, and I'm
5 one of the group of five or more from the
6 building next door.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Perfect. Ms.
8 Yohannes, who is protesting this matter?

9 MS. YOHANNES: It is just a group of
10 five or more.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Just wanted to
12 make sure. Thank you. Ms. Yohannes, are there
13 any preliminary matters in this case?

14 MS. YOHANNES: No, not for the
15 applicant.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Steinberg,
17 are there any preliminary matters in this case?

18 MS. STEINBERG: No.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. If
20 this matter, then, is not -- this matter says
21 that there is a protest hearing on July 27, but
22 that's not -- well, yes, we're still in June. I
23 don't know why I believe that we're in July. All
24 right. I'm sorry. This matter, then, is
25 scheduled for a protest hearing on July 27, 2022

1 at 1:30 p.m. If this matter is not settled. Are
2 both parties aware of the protest procedures or
3 do I need to review them for the parties?

4 MS. STEINBERG: Unfortunately, we are
5 familiar with them.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
7 Thank you, Ms. Steinberg. I know that Ms.
8 Yohannes is, so, therefore, I just want to remind
9 both parties that seven days prior to the hearing
10 you are required to submit your PIP to the
11 applicant and also to ABRA legal. And just to
12 remind you that if the PIP is not provided to the
13 other party and to the agency that the Board
14 might prohibit you from relying on documents and
15 witnesses that have not been disclosed unless due
16 process is shown why the PIP was not done. If
17 either party have any questions and concerns
18 during the period, you are welcome to call Ms.
19 Imani Moreland at (202)-442-6942. The Board
20 supports settlement agreements, so if the parties
21 are able to settle this matter, we do support the
22 parties settling matters. If this matter, then,
23 is not settled, then we will see you on July 27,
24 2022 at 1:30 p.m. for the protest hearing. Thank
