22	Before we get underway with today's
23	hearing calendar, I need to make a few
24	instructions very clear so that the conduct of
25	this hearing is understood by everyone.

There are six cases scheduled for this morning's calendar. Once a case is called, I will take a moment for our IT specialist to elevate the rights for each party to enable their camera and microphone. Then, and only then, will you have the ability to enable your equipment.

If your case is not being heard, you will remain mute, and your camera will be disabled. At the conclusion of each case, the parties will have the option to leave. If the party chooses to stay, all cameras and microphones for the conclusion of the case will be disabled.

Our first order of business today is a protest hearing status, Case Number 21-PRO-00021, Alice Bar and Lounge, License Number 117897.
