3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, the
4	next case on our calendar is Case Number 21-PRO-
5	00028, Union Liquor, License Number 109197.
6	Ms. Andrews, can you please elevate
7	the rights of the Licensee and the Protestants in
8	this case, please?
9	MS. ANDREWS: Sure, stand by.
10	Mr. Lee has been elevated.
11	(Pause.)
12	MS. ANDREWS: That's all, Mr. Chair.
13	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The Licensee in
14	this I'm sorry, the Protestant in this case is
15	ANC 8A. And who I have here is Jamila White. If
16	Ms. Jamila White, if she's on this case, can you
17	please identify yourself in the chat, please.
18	(No audible response.)
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: If there a
20	representative for ANC 8A on the line, on the
21	call, can you please identify yourself and we'll
22	elevate your rights.
23	(No audible response.)
24	Mr. Lee, can you mute your line,
25	please. Thank you.

1	All right, what I'm going to do, Mr.
2	Lee, I will recall this case. I will go to the
3	calendar, and I will recall this case. And if
4	the ANC is not there, I'll make a motion that we
5	dismiss their protest.
6	MR. LEE: All right, thanks.
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
8	Ms. Andrews, can you do what you need
9	to do, please?
10	MS. ANDREWS: Sure, stand by.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
12	(Whereupon, the above-entitled matter
13	went off the record at 10:43 a.m. and resumed at
14	12:02 p.m.)
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The
16	next case in our calendar that I'm recalling is
17	Case Number 21-PRO-00028. This is Union Liquor,
18	License Number 109197.
19	Ms. Andrews, can you please elevate
20	the rights of the Licensee and the Counsel, I
21	think, Mr. Kevin Lee, and the Protestant which is
22	ANC 8A?
23	MS. ANDREWS: Sure. Mr. Lee, your
24	rights have been elevated. That's all, Mr. Chair.
25	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. All

1	right, just let me see something here. It's just
2	one as before. I'm trying to clarify something
3	in my mind.
4	All right. This case was scheduled
5	for a protest hearing at 10:30. I called the
6	case at 10:30, and ANC 8A did not appear. And it
7	is now 12:04, and I'm recalling the case. And
8	ANC 8A, it still didn't appear. Is there a
9	motion that you wish to make, Mr. Lee? Mr. Lee?
10	MR. LEE: Hey, can you me?
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I cannot hear
12	you, Mr. Lee.
13	MR. LEE: Hello?
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, sir.
15	MR. LEE: Yes, hi. Good afternoon,
16	Board members. My name is Kevin Lee representing
17	Union Liquors in the matter of a protest.
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is there, I see
19	that ANC is the Protestant. I'm recalling the
20	case, and the ANC is not here. Is there a motion
21	you wish to make, sir?
22	MR. LEE: Yes.
23	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What is that,
24	sir?
25	MR. LEE: Yes, a motion to dismiss,

1	because they are absent to the status hearing.
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: As I said
3	before, this matter was scheduled for a protest
4	hearing at, a status hearing at 10:30. This case
5	was called at 10:30. ANC failed to appear.
6	The Licensee was here the first time
7	the case was called. It is now 12:05. I'm
8	recalling the case. I'm sorry, the Licensee is
9	here, and the Protestant is not here.
10	I then, pursuant to the motion made by
11	the Licensee, I then make a motion that the
12	protest by ANC 8A is dismissed. Is there a
13	second?
14	MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis has
15	seconded.
16	MEMBER SHORT: James Short, second.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis and
18	Mr. Short have seconded the motion. We'll now
19	have a roll call vote on the motion.
20	Mr. Short?
21	MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.
22	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?
23	MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I
24	agree.
25	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

1	MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?
3	MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I
4	agree.
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson,
6	I agree. The matter passed 5, 0, 0. The motion
7	that was passed is to dismiss the protest filed
8	on the ANC and to authorize the Agency to move
9	forward with the process of renewing the
10	application for the Licensee.
11	The ANC will be given ten days once
12	the petition is written to file a motion for
13	reconsideration to provide the Agency with good
14	cause why they failed to appear today.
15	If the ANC fails to appear, I'm sorry,
16	fails to respond to our written notice or to give
17	us good cause, then the Agency will move forward
18	with the process of renewing this license.
19	Thank you for your appearance today,
20	Mr. Lee. Have a great day. Thank you very much.
21	MR. LEE: Thank you very much for your
22	time.
23	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thanks, bye-bye.
