3 MS. FLETCHER: I'm going to call the
4 last case on the calendar for today.

5 The last case on the calendar is
6 Calico. This is Case No. 22-PRO-00055, Alley
7 Cats Hospitality, 50 Blagden Alley, N.W., License
8 No. ABRA-104594. This is a Retailer Class CR,
9 License Renewal. The protest issues are adverse
10 impact on peace, order, and quiet, residential
11 parking and vehicular and pedestrian safety, and
12 real property values.

13 Is anyone present on behalf of Calico?

14 MS. MAHMOUD: Good morning, Ms.
15 Fletcher. This is Manalle Mahmoud with Mallios
16 O'Brien & Sandground, M-A-N-A-L-L-E, M-A-H-M-O-U-

18 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Mahmoud.
19 Is anyone present on behalf of Blagden Alley
20 Naylor Court Association? Is anybody present on
21 behalf of Blagden Alley Naylor Court Association?

22 I am going to recall this case in a
23 moment. I am going to go back to the first case
24 on the calendar to give the Protestant an
25 opportunity to appear. So the hearing in this

1 matter is concluded.

5 MS. FLETCHER: I am recalling the case
6 of Calico, Case No. 22-PRO-00055. Is anyone
7 present on behalf of Blagden Alley Naylor Court
8 Association? Ms. Mahmoud?

9 MS. MAHMOUD: Yes, Ms. Fletcher.

10 MS. FLETCHER: The Protestant is not
11 present, which means that the protest is
12 dismissed. The Board will issue an order
13 dismissing the protest because the Protestant is
14 not present.

15 You will receive a copy of the order.
16 The Protestant will have ten days to seek
17 reinstatement. If they do, you will receive a
18 copy of that so that you can respond.

19 If the Board grants reinstatement of
20 the protest, then I will contact you to schedule
21 a mediation. And you would also be informed of
22 the status and protest hearing dates. But as of
23 today, the protest has been dismissed.

24 MS. MAHMOUD: Thank you so much, Ms.
25 Fletcher.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Mahmoud.
2 Maybe I'll see you soon.

3 MS. MAHMOUD: Have a great day.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. You, too. All
5 right. Take care.

6 MS. MAHMOUD: You, too.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Is there anyone else on
8 the line who I have not called? Okay. Well,
9 thank you.
