3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the  
4 calendar is Steins Caf,. This is case no. 22-  
5 PRO-00058. Bars by Breedlove, LLC. 4630 14th  
6 Street NW. License no. ABRA 114522. This is a  
7 Retailer Class CR license renewal. The protest  
8 issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and  
9 quiet, residential parking, and vehicular and  
10 pedestrian safety. My name is LaVerne Fletcher,  
11 conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's  
12 agent.

16 MR. CAMPBELL: Yes, Ms. Fletcher.  
17 Ulysses Campbell, ANC 4C03 Commissioner.

18 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Mr.  
19 Campbell, did you receive the WebEx invitation I  
20 sent you this morning?

21 MR. CAMPBELL: I did. Thank you very  
22 much.

23 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. Thank  
24 you. Well, I just wanted to make sure which  
25 invitation you signed in on, so I'm glad you got

1 the one I sent you this morning. Thank you.

2 MR. CAMPBELL: Thank you. I had  
3 actually just reached out to Sarah Fashbaugh,  
4 asked how I was going to be able to participate.  
5 And then I had to quickly dash off another email  
6 saying, disregard that. I already got the  
7 invitation. So you were very thorough.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Perfect. Is there  
9 anyone present for Steins Caf,? The time is  
10 approximately 10:15. There's no one present on  
11 behalf of Steins Caf,. Therefore, the  
12 application is dismissed because the Applicant is  
13 not present.

14 Mr. Campbell, the ANC will receive a  
15 copy of the Board order that will be sent to the  
16 Applicant, dismissing the application because  
17 they're not present today. And the Applicant  
18 will have 10 days, upon receipt of that Board  
19 order, to seek reinstatement. But if they do,  
20 you'll receive a copy of the request for  
21 reinstatement and have an opportunity to respond.

22 The Applicant will have to explain to  
23 the Board why he or she is not present today. If  
24 the Board accepts that explanation and reinstates  
25 the application, then I will contact you to

1 schedule mediation, status hearing, the protest  
2 hearing. The case will just get back on track.  
3 But the Board order will be issued, and you will  
4 be kept informed.

5 MR. CAMPBELL: Thank you, Ms.  
6 Fletcher.

7 MS. FLETCHER: You are very welcome.  
8 And any questions about that, Mr. Campbell?

9 MR. CAMPBELL: No, ma'am.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Well, ANC 4C does have  
11 standing as a protestant. And so we'll move  
12 forward and see what happens next.

13 MR. CAMPBELL: Indeed.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.  
15 Thanks for coming.

16 MR. CAMPBELL: Thank you.

17 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. The  
18 roll call hearing is concluded. Have a good day.

19 MR. CAMPBELL: You too.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
