Itittig filed a protest. They informed me that they would not be present today. And their protest is going to be dismissed this morning but not because they're not present.

The protest is going to be dismissed because they're not part of a group of five or more, and they did not claim to be abutting property owners, and it does not appear that they are abutting property owners in the D.C.

Geographic Information System. So those are the reasons that the protest is dismissed. I just wanted to be clear that they're not being dismissed because they're not here today.

We need to set a date for mediation, a status hearing, and the protest hearing. Give me one second.
