MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you. I'm calling the case now of Joe Caplan Liquors. Joe Caplan Liquors. This is Case Number 21-PRO00043, DK Corporation trading as Joe Caplan Liquors, 1913 7th Street Northwest, License Number ABRA-060351. This is a Retailer Class A License renewal.

Who is present on behalf of Joe Caplan

## Liquors?

MS. MAHMOUD: Hi. Good morning, Ms. Fletcher. Manalle Mahmoud. I'm with the law firm Mallios O'Brien \& Sandground. We're representing Joe Caplan Liquors in this matter.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you. Ms. Mahmoud, would you please spell your name for the record?

MS. MAHMOUD: Of course. $M$ as in Mary, $A, N$ as in Nancy, A-L-L-E, last name Mahmoud, M as in Mary, A-H-M-O-U-D.

MS. FLETCHER: What's the last letter?
MS. MAHMOUD: D as in dog.
MS. FLETCHER: D as in dog. Thank you.

MS. MAHMOUD: Of course.
MS. FLETCHER: And so we also have several groups of individuals that filed protest. So we have one group, appears to be represented by Elaine Gin.

Ms. Gin, are you present?
MS. GIN: Yes, I am.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Would you please spell your name for the record?

MS. GIN: Absolutely. It's Elaine Gin, E-L-A-I-N-E. Gin is spelled G-I-N.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Ms. Gin, are there any other individuals present from your group today?

MS. GIN: Yes. I believe Richard Myers.

MR. MYERS: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Mr. Myers, would you please state your name and spell it for the record?

MR. MYERS: Richard, R-I-C-H-A-R-D, Myers, M-Y-E-R-S.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Myers.
Anyone else present from your group today, Ms. Gin?

MS. GIN: Yes. Jon Combs.
MS. FLETCHER: Jon, would you please state your name and spell it for the record?

MR. COMBS: Yes. Jon Combs, J-O-N, C-O-M-B-S.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
Anyone else?
MS. GIN: I believe Leo Jennings is on it.

MR. JENNINGS: Yes, I am. My name -first name, Leo, L-E-O, last name Jennings, J-E-N-N-I-N-G-S, like Sam.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
Anyone else?
MS. GIN: Ken Bourassa is trying to log on, and he's having some technical issues.

MS. FLETCHER: And who is that person?
MS. GIN: Ken Bourassa.
MS. FLETCHER: Do you know how to spell that name?

MS. GIN: K-E-N, B-O- (audio interference).

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MS. FLETCHER: B-O- what?
MS. GIN: B-O-U --
MS. FLETCHER: Did you say B as in
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boy?
MS. GIN: Yes. B as in boy, O-U-R-A-S-S-A.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So Mr. Bourassa is -- is attempting to sign in, but he's having trouble getting in?

MS. GIN: That's correct.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Anyone else?
MS. GIN: No, that's it.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Ms. Gin, I'm going to consider at least five people from your group to be present today, which means that the group of five that you represent are granted full standing as protestants.

MS. GIN: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: I've noted for the record that Mr. Bourassa was having trouble getting in. That happens sometimes, but we don't hold that against anybody.

MS. GIN: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you. So the group of five represented by Elaine Gin -and, Ms. Gin, you are the designated representative, yes?

MS. GIN: I - I am.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.
And we have another group of individuals represented by Sarah Greggord.

Ms. Greggord, are you present?
(Pause.)
Is Sarah Greggord present?
(Pause.)
Is anyone else present from that group? I'll call the names in case you're not sure that's your group.

Okay. So some of this handwriting I cannot read. Let me try glasses. It's -- so Sarah Greggord -- could you mute your background, whoever -- I don't know who I can hear, but I can hear somebody. If you're not -- if your case is not being called, would you please mute your microphone?

So Sarah Greggord is not present. Is Eduardo Cierone present or Lopez Escoliar present? What about John Master? Is John Master present?

There's another name that's not really legible, but it looks like Higgin or Higgins. Is there a Mr. or Ms. Higgins present?

What about Erica Mustos? Is Erica

Mustos present?
(Pause.)
The group being represented by Sarah Greggord is dismissed because neither of the parties are present today.

We have a third group. Is Michael
Wayne present today?
(Pause.)
Is anyone else present from Mr. Wayne's group today?

Okay. So I don't know who's speaking. Ms. Gaffney, is that you? Somebody needs to mute their microphone. And I'm -- I'm -- I'm asking you, Ms. Gaffney, because your -- your -- your screen lit up.

MS. GAFFNEY: I'm the guilty person. I'm sorry.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
So let me go down this list. Michael Wayne is not present. What about $D$ as in dog, E-V-I -- that's the first name. The last name appears to be Mahadevia. I'm going to spell that. M-A-H-A-D-, like dog, -E-V-I-A. Is that person present?

What about Dan? D-A-N, Jedzinok. I'm
going to spell that. It's spelled J-E-D-, like dog, -Z-I-N-O-K. Is that person present?

What about Diego? D-I-E-G-O? Looks like Buchala. I'll spell that. B like boy, U-C-H-A-L-A. Is Diego present?

The last person is Betina Hennig. Is Betina Hennig present? That's spelled B-E-T-, like Tom, -I-N-A, H-E-N-N-I-G. Is that person present? Is that person present, or am I hearing an echo? Is Ms. Hennig present?
(Pause.)
Okay. There's no one present from the group represented by Mr. Wayne. That group of five is dismissed.

And then we have left two other individuals that filed a protest. Is John Webster present? John Webster? John Webster? Is John Webster present?

What about David Harris?
(Pause.)
Mr. Webster and Mr. Harris are dismissed, first of all because they failed to appear today, but second of all, they're not part of a group of five. And neither one of them filed protests as abutting property owners. John

Webster and David Harris are dismissed.
So we have one group of five represented by Elaine Gin. We need to set a date for mediation, a status hearing, and a protest hearing. I have the status hearing and protest hearing dates for you, so I'll give you those dates.

The status hearing is set for August 18 at 10:30 a.m. August 18 at 10:30.

MS. MAHMOUD: That works for me.
MR. MYERS: I won't be in town. This is Richard Myers.

MS. FLETCHER: Did you say -- are you speaking to me, LaVerne Fletcher? Or are you -are you all talking to each other? I mean, what
(Simultaneous speaking.)
MS. FLETCHER: -- anybody speaking to -- is anybody speaking to LaVerne Fletcher?

MR. MYERS: I have a question.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Mr. Myers, which -- Mr. Myers, which case are you here for?

MR. MYERS: With Elaine Gin.
MS. FLETCHER: You're with Elaine Gin. Okay. I'm listening.

MR. MYERS: So the date of 18th -August 18th, does all five have to be at the status hearing?

MS. FLETCHER: No. Thanks for asking. Because five of you are present today, at the status hearing only Ms. Gin needs to appear.

MR. MYERS: Okay. Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you for checking.
MS. GIN: And -- and -- and this is Elaine Gin. That -- that day and time works for me.

MS. FLETCHER: I'm sorry. What did you say, Ms. Gin?

MS. GIN: That date and time works for me.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.
The protest hearing is set for September 30th, 3:30. September 30 at 3:30 p.m. for the protest hearing.

We need to set a date for mediation, so I'll give you the next available day. The next available day for mediation is Thursday, July 22nd, anytime between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 22nd.

MS. GIN: This is Elaine Gin. Can we
have a -- that day does not work for me.
MS. FLETCHER: What was that, Ms. Gin?
MS. GIN: That -- that day, it does not work for me. Can we have a later date?

MS. FLETCHER: Oh, yeah. We can move to -- we can do Friday the 23rd, or we can move to the following week.

MS. GIN: Following week is better for me. Thank you.

MS. FLETCHER: What about Tuesday, July 27?

MS. GIN: Tuesday, July 27th, it is.
MS. FLETCHER: Is that okay for you, Ms. Mahmoud?

MS. MAHMOUD: Yes. That date works, preferably later on in the day if there is an afternoon time available.

MS. FLETCHER: What about 2:00?
MS. MAHMOUD: That's wonderful.
MS. FLETCHER: Is that -- is that okay
for you, Ms. Gin?
MS. GIN: Yes, that works. Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.
MR. MYERS: Question again, Ms.
Fletcher.

MS. FLETCHER: Who's that speaking?
MR. MYERS: Richard Myers.
MS. FLETCHER: Yes, Mr. Myers?
MR. MYERS: For the mediation, who can attend that?

MS. FLETCHER: Well, we only need the designated representative for mediation, but you're a protestant, so you're -- you're welcome to attend. But generally the designated representative attends on behalf of a group.

MR. MYERS: Okay. Thank you again.
MS. FLETCHER: Mediation is set for Tuesday, July 27, at 2:00. Any questions at all?

MS. MAHMOUD: No. Thank you, Ms. Fletcher.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, you're welcome. Thank you for coming. The roll call hearing in the matter of Joe Caplan Liquors is concluded.
