3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case is Lee's
4 Liquor. It's Case Number --

5 (Simultaneous speaking.)

6 MS. FLETCHER: -- Case Number -- Case
7 Number 21-PRO-00049, Daniman LLC, 2339
8 Pennsylvania Avenue Southeast, License Number
9 ABRA-095751. This is a Retailer Class A License
10 renewal. The protest issues are adverse impact
11 on peace, order, and quiet.

12 Who is present on behalf of Lee's
13 Liquor?

14 MR. LEE: Yeah. Good morning. My
15 name is Kevin Lee, K-E-V-I-N, L-E-E, representing
16 Lee's Liquor. Before we go, I just got protest
17 withdrawal letter from Ms. Brown, Tiffany, from
18 ANC -- ANC 7B.

19 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you, Mr.
20 Lee. So you did receive the withdrawal notice
21 from -- from ANC 7B?

22 MR. LEE: Yeah. They just submitted
23 in the middle of our hearing today.

24 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you.

25 (Simultaneous speaking.)

1 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
2 So what that means is the -- excuse me one
3 second. I'm just making a note of that, Mr. Lee.

4 Okay. Thank you. So we will process
5 that withdrawal and close out this case.

6 MS. BROWN: Ms. Fletcher?

7 MS. FLETCHER: Yes?

8 MS. BROWN: Hi. This is Tiffany
9 Brown, ANC 7B Chair. For some reason, I had this
10 hearing down for the 15th. Is that another -- I
11 have so many --

12 (Simultaneous speaking.)

13 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, you know what it
14 is? Yeah. So that's probably the status
15 hearing, but I'll double-check that.

16 MS. BROWN: Okay.

17 MS. FLETCHER: So I'm going to double-
18 check that for you, Ms. Brown.

19 MS. BROWN: But that's fine. We
20 withdrew it. Everything's good.

21 MS. FLETCHER: I'm just going to make
22 sure you get -- I think that's what that date is
23 for. So you've withdrawn your protest, and it
24 doesn't matter what that date is for now because
25 it's -- we're -- we're going to close the case

1 out.

2 And, Ms. Brown, let me just note for
3 the record that you're here on behalf of ANC 7B.

4 MS. BROWN: Yes.

5 MS. FLETCHER: And could you spell
6 your name and state it for the record?

7 MS. BROWN: Sure. Tiffany, T-I-F-F-A-
8 N-Y, middle initial L, last name Brown, B-R-O-W-
9 N. I'm the Chairperson for ANC 7B.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So then I do not
11 -- actually don't need to provide you with any
12 dates. So we don't need mediation.

13 MR. LEE: I'm just making sure that --
14 so we need to get a Board order for this one, or
15 --

16 MS. FLETCHER: That's -- that's what
17 happens next. What happens next -- Ms. Brown,
18 you have submitted your withdrawal to April
19 Randall?

20 (Simultaneous speaking.)

21 MS. FLETCHER: -- submit it to April?
22 Huh?

23 MS. BROWN: I sent it to the ABRA
24 Legal.

25 MS. FLETCHER: That's perfect. That

1 gets to April.

2 MS. BROWN: Okay.

3 MS. FLETCHER: And so there's nothing
4 else you need to do. Once April gets that,
5 she'll take care of the rest.

6 And so, yeah, you'll get a Board order
7 dismissing this protest because it was withdrawn.

8 MS. BROWN: Okay.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Any other question, Mr.
10 Lee?

11 MR. LEE: That's all. Thank you very
12 much.

13 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.

14 Ms. Brown, thanks for coming.

15 MS. BROWN: Thank you, but I do have
16 another question for you.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

18 MS. BROWN: All right. Not about
19 Lee's. Is Fairfax Liquors on this --

20 MS. FLETCHER: It is. It is.

21 MS. BROWN: Okay. So I am at the
22 right place for at least something.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Well, you can just stay
24 right there.

25 MS. BROWN: I'll stay right here.

1 MS. FLETCHER: And that is actually
2 coming up next.

3 MS. BROWN: Okay.

4 MR. LEE: Ms. -- Ms. Fletcher?

5 MS. FLETCHER: Yes?

6 MR. LEE: There's another case. I
7 just looked back to the 7 Food Store case, and in
8 that did Mr. Dixon represent the Agency?

9 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. -- Mr. -- Mr. Lee,
10 you're talking about a previous case?

11 MR. LEE: Yes.

12 MS. FLETCHER: That case has been
13 closed. So although weird --

14 MR. LEE: Okay. All right.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Although weird, I can
16 talk to you --

17 MR. LEE: All right. That's okay.
18 That's okay. I just --

19 (Simultaneous speaking.)

20 MS. FLETCHER: But whatever you're
21 going to ask me about that, send me an email and
22 I'll respond.

23 MR. LEE: Okay. And then, you know,
24 I'm sorry about that --

25 (Simultaneous speaking.)

1 MR. LEE: -- about the (audio
2 interference) today. I don't know. It -- it
3 happened twice. I'm sorry about that.

4 MS. FLETCHER: No problem.

5 MR. LEE: All right.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Let's see here. So the
7 matter of Lee's Liquor is closed. That roll call
8 hearing is concluded.

9 (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter
10 went off the record at 11:04 a.m.)
