6 Ms. Fashbaugh, can you please elevate the parties
7 in this case, please? I see that Ms. Yohannes is
8 already here.

9 MS. FASHBAUGH: Please stand by. Brian
10 Romanowski, your rights have been elevated. That
11 is all Mr. Chair.
