MS. FLETCHER: Good morning. My name is LaVerne Fletcher. I'm conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. I'd like to thank you for attending the roll call hearing via the WebEx platform provided by the D.C. Office of Open Government.

I am calling the case of Bowen
Discount, case number 21-PRO-00054, Bowen
Enterprises, Inc., 4510 Bowen Road, Southeast,
license number ABRA 073781. This is a retailer
class A license renewal. The protest issues are
adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet.

Who is present on behalf of ANC 7E?

MS. T. FLETCHER: Hi, this is Tiera

Fletcher, Commissioner of 7E02.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Fletcher. Would you please spell your name for the record?

MS. T. FLETCHER: Sure, Tiera, that's T-I-E-R-A, and then Fletcher, F-L-E-T-C-H-E-R.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much,
Ms. Fletcher. I see that Mr. Hundal has joined
us. Good morning, Mr. Hundal.

2	Hundal.	
3	MS. FLETCHER: Is that Ms. Hundal?	
4	Ms. Hundal, can you hear me? Ms. Hundal, you'll	
5	need to unmute your microphone.	
6	MS. HUNDAL: Hello?	
7	MS. FLETCHER: Good morning.	
8	MS. HUNDAL: Good morning. Good	
9	morning.	
10	MS. FLETCHER: Good morning, Ms.	
11	Hundal. This is LaVerne Fletcher speaking.	
12	MS. HUNDAL: Yes, ma'am.	
13	MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Fletcher is present	
14	from ANC 7E also. Would you please state your	
15	name and spell it for the record?	
16	MS. HUNDAL: R-A-J-I-N-D-E-R H-U-N-D-	
17	A-L, Rajinder Hundal.	
18	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.	
19	ANC 7E has standing as a protestant. We need to	
20	set a date for a mediation, the status hearing.	
21	I don't have your protest hearing date available	
22	today.	
23	MS. T. FLETCHER: So, I would just	
24	like to note that we are attempting to do a	
25	settlement agreement. I know that until that's	

done, we still have to follow the process, but I 1 2 just wanted to note --3 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. 4 MS. T. FLETCHER: -- that I'm working 5 on the agreement and Ms. Hundal is also 6 interested. Well, at least, you know, my 7 understanding is that she's interested in a 8 settlement as well. 9 MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Hundal, you agree with that? 10 11 Yes, I agree. MS. HUNDAL: 12 So, Ms. Fletcher, you MS. FLETCHER: 13 are correct. I'll go ahead and we'll set up the 14 dates and then they'll be canceled if the 15 settlement agreement is submitted. 16 I'm going to give you the date for the status hearing first. The date for the status 17 18 hearing is August 18. That's August 18 at 10:30 19 a.m., August 18 at 10:30 a.m. for the status 20 hearing. 21 MS. T. FLETCHER: That works for me. 22 I don't know if it's flexible or not, but it works for me if it also works for Ms. Hundal. 23 24 MS. HUNDAL: Yes, it works for me. 25 Okay, well, I will give MS. FLETCHER:

	you the next available date for mediation. What	
2	about the week of we could do it as early as	
3	this Friday, but I'm thinking you would want to	
4	push it out further to give you more time to	
5	finalize the settlement agreement?	
6	MS. T. FLETCHER: That would be	
7	helpful if it's also helpful for Ms. Hundal, yes.	
8	MS. FLETCHER: What about August,	
9	Friday, August 13?	
10	MS. HUNDAL: August 13?	
11	MS. FLETCHER: Yes, Friday, August 13.	
12	MS. HUNDAL: That day, I am out of	
13	town. Is it possible we can have another date?	
14	MS. FLETCHER: We can do Thursday,	
15	August 12.	
16	MS. HUNDAL: That weekend actually I	
17	have a wedding starting from Wednesday to	
18	Thursday, Friday, Saturday.	
19	MS. FLETCHER: Can you say that again?	
20	MS. HUNDAL: It's a wedding, you know.	
21	MS. T. FLETCHER: Wedding.	
22	MS. HUNDAL: Yeah, it's a wedding	
23	Thursday, Friday, Saturday that week, you know.	
24	That's why	
25	MS. FLETCHER: Okay.	

1	MS. HUNDAL: another date, another,	
2	you know.	
3	MS. FLETCHER: Yes, we can what	
4	about Friday, August 6?	
5	MS. HUNDAL: Friday, yeah, that can	
6	work.	
7	MS. FLETCHER: That will work?	
8	MS. T. FLETCHER: That will work for	
9	me also.	
10	MS. FLETCHER: Do you have a	
11	preference for morning or afternoon? We can do	
12	it anytime between 9:00 and 2:00.	
13	MS. HUNDAL: Morning is good. Morning	
14	is good. 9:00 is good.	
15	MS. T. FLETCHER: Yes, I would do it	
16	earlier as well.	
17	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, well, 9:00 works	
18	on this end, so mediation is set for August 6 at	
19	9:00 a.m., and if you enter into a settlement	
20	agreement before that, you can just let me know	
21	and I'll cancel the mediation, and if you submit	
22	it for Board approval prior to August 18, then	
23	the status hearing will be canceled also.	
24	Ms. Fletcher, submit the settlement	
25	agreement to April Randall. You've heard from

20	settlement is accepted by the Board prior to the	
21	status hearing, then the status hearing will also	
22	be canceled?	
23	MS. FLETCHER: Yes.	
24	MS. T. FLETCHER: Okay, and	
25	MS. FLETCHER: Exactly.	

1	MS. T. FLETCHER: if we submit the	
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3	MS. HUNDAL: The status hearing was	
4	August 18?	
5	MS. FLETCHER: So, who is speaking,	
6	Ms. Hundal?	
7	MS. HUNDAL: Yes, I said the status	
8	hearing was on August 18?	
9	MS. FLETCHER: Yes, August 18 at	
10	10:30.	
11	MS. HUNDAL: Oh, okay. Okay, I'm just	
12	writing the dates and times. Okay, go ahead.	
13	MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Fletcher	
14	MS. T. FLETCHER: Yes?	
15	MS. FLETCHER: and Ms. Hundal, if	
16	you would like, I will send you, email you April	
17	Randall's contact information, but you do have it	
18	on that letter that you received from Ms.	
19	Randall, but I'll send it to you just to make	
20	sure you have her email address.	
21	MS. T. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.	
22	MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. Any	
23	other questions? Ms. Hundal?	
24	MS. T. FLETCHER: Just a quick	
25	question, if we submit the settlement and it	

1	hasn't been approved prior to the status hearing,
2	will we still have the status hearing?
3	MS. FLETCHER: No, once you submit it,
4	the status hearing will be canceled.
5	MS. T. FLETCHER: Okay, okay,
6	understood.
7	MS. FLETCHER: And if you submit it
8	prior to August 6, the mediation will be
9	canceled.
10	MS. T. FLETCHER: Okay, understood,
11	thank you.
12	MS. FLETCHER: They'll both be
13	canceled, both hearings.
14	MS. T. FLETCHER: Got it, thank you.
15	MS. FLETCHER: Well, the mediation is
16	not a hearing, but it would be canceled. Ms.
17	Hundal, do you have any questions?
18	MS. HUNDAL: No.
19	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, well, thank you
20	very much for coming.
21	MS. HUNDAL: You're welcome.
22	MS. FLETCHER: The roll call hearing
