CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case in our calendar is Case #22-CMP-00035, Mad Hatter. License number 82646.

Ms. Fashbaugh, can you please elevate the licensee in this case please.

MS. FASHBAUGH: Please standby.

Eric Heidenberger, your rights have been elevated.

That is all, Mr. Chair.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.

MR. HEIDENBERGER: Good morning.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: One minute, sir please. All right. Good morning, Mr. Celo, can you please spell and state your name for the record please?

MR. CELO: Assistant Attorney General Anthony Celo, A-N-T-H-O-N-Y C-E-L-O on behalf of the district.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.

Mr. Heidenberger, can you please spell and state your name for the record please?

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
3 sir.

4 Mr. Celo, are there any preliminary
5 matters in this case?

6 MR. CELO: Mr. Chair, I would just
7 note that an Offer in Compromise has been
8 extended, but the attorney assigned to the case
9 has not heard back from the establishment yet.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
11 Thank you.

12 All right. This matter then is
13 scheduled for a show cause hearing on August
14 10, 2022, at 10:30 a.m.

15 I want to alert the parties that seven
16 days prior to the hearing you are required to
17 exchange documents and witnesses. What that
18 means sir, is seven days before the hearing you
19 are supposed to provide the office, if you're
20 going to go to the hearing, you have to provide
21 the assigned attorney with the documents and
22 witnesses that you're going to rely on at the
23 hearing. And you should also provide a copy to
24 ABRA legal.

25 Do you have any questions, sir?

1 MR. HEIDENBERGER: No. Thank you.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

3 Thank you.

4 And the parties are, if the matter
5 can't be settled, the parties are welcome to
6 settle this matter under the board now. But if
7 not, we will see you on August 10, 2022, at
8 10:30 a.m.

9 MR. HEIDENBERGER: Mr. Celo, did you
10 send that to -- do you have the address where
11 you sent that Offer in Compromise?

12 MR. CELO: Hold on --

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry.
14 Who's the attorney assigned to this case, Mr.
15 Celo?

16 MR. CELO: This case is assigned to
17 Attorney Kevin Lutes.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. So
19 Mr. --

20 MR. CELO: I can provide you his
21 email.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. So
23 why don't you just provide your email, and
24 we'll make sure that the attorney of record
25 will contact you directly, sir.

1 MR. HEIDENBERGER: Okay.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. So
3 I guess, Mr. Celo, you can either provide --
4 give him -- what's the email address sir?

5 MR. CELO: The email address you can
6 reach attorney Lutes at is Kevin, K-E-V-I-N --
7 let me know when you're ready.

8 MR. HEIDENBERGER: Yes.

9 MR. CELO: Kevin K-E-V-I-N, Lutes --
10 sorry, dot Lutes L-U-T-E-S @dc.gov.

11 MR. HEIDENBERGER: kevin.lutes@dc.gov?

12 MR. CELO: Yes, sir.

13 MR. HEIDENBERGER: Okay. Thank you.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Celo. I
15 would also ask you just, at the same time could
16 you have Mr. Lutes reach out to Mr.
17 Heidenberger?

18 MR. CELO: Yes.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Just so both
