3 MS. FLETCHER: I'm going to go ahead  
4 with our introduction and then we can wait a few  
5 more minutes to give the Applicant an opportunity  
6 to join.

7 I'd like to thank you for joining  
8 ABRA's roll call hearing being conducted via the  
9 Webex platform provided by the DC Office of Open  
10 Government.

11 MR. ADOFO: Thank you. I appreciate  
12 it.

13 MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.  
14 It is approximately -- it looks like it's just  
15 after 10 o'clock, and I need to allow at least 10  
16 minutes for the Applicant to arrive. So we'll  
17 wait a little bit.

18 Mr. Adofo, I take it you're going to  
19 be the only person attending on behalf of the ANC  
20 8C today?

21 MR. ADOFO: That is confirmed.

22 MS. FLETCHER: Have you had any  
23 communication with the Applicant at all before  
24 today?

25 MR. ADOFO: No, ma'am.

1 MS. FLETCHER: It's approximately  
2 10:05. The Applicant has not yet arrived. I'm  
3 going to go ahead and call the case and then  
4 we'll wait a little bit longer.

5 This is the matter of Spar Liquor,  
6 Haben Liquors Inc., Case Number 21-PRO-00055,  
7 3916 South Capitol Street Southeast, License  
8 Number ABRA 105207. This is a Retailer Class A  
9 License Renewal.

10 The protest issues are adverse impact  
11 on peace or on quiet. We'll continue to wait for  
12 an additional four minutes or so for the  
13 Applicant to arrive.

14 The time is approximately 10:10. The  
15 Applicant has not yet arrived, which means that  
16 the Application to Renew the License is  
17 dismissed.

18 Mr. Adofo, that means that the Board  
19 issues an Order dismissing the License Renewal  
20 Application, and you'll receive a copy of the  
21 Order.

22 The Applicant will have 10 days to  
23 seek reinstatement of the application, and you  
24 will have an opportunity to respond to that. If  
25 the Board reinstates the application, we'll let

1 you know.

2 MR. ADOFO: Yes, ma'am.

3 MS. FLETCHER: We'll proceed from  
4 there. And we'll schedule the mediation, the  
5 status hearing and a protest hearing. There  
6 aren't going to be any dates scheduled today.  
7 Thank you for coming.

8 MR. ADOFO: Thank you.

9 MS. FLETCHER: And we'll be in touch.

10 MR. ADOFO: Thank you.

11 MS. FLETCHER: The roll call hearing  
12 is concluded.
