The offer in compromise for this case states in part and in parts. Charge 1, sale of an alcoholic beverage to a person under the age of 21, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25 781. The fine is a fine of \$2,000 paid within 60 days, or its license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid. Number 2, suspension. The license shall be suspended for five days with all five days to be stayed for one year from the date of adjudication pursuant -- providing there are no further violations in the year.

And, number 3, all employees who serve alcoholic beverages in the licensed establishment shall complete an alcohol training program within three months from the date of adjudication from one of the alcohol awareness training program vendors.
