3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the
4 calendar is Lidl, Case Number 22-PRO-00068, Lidl
5 US Operations, LLC., 2224 Town Center Drive,
6 Southeast, License Number ABRA 119890, this is a
7 Retailer Class A, Substantial Change to change
8 the hours.

9 The protest issues are adverse impact
10 on peace, order, and quiet.

11 Is there anyone present on behalf of
12 the Applicant?

13 MS. MAHMOUD: Hi, good morning, Ms.
14 Fletcher. This is Manalle Mahmoud with Mallios
15 O'Brien and Sandground, on behalf of the
16 Applicant, M-A-N-A-L-L-E, M-A-H-M-O-U-D.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Mahmoud.
18 Is anyone present on behalf of ANC 7B?

19 Ms. Brown, can you hear me?

20 MS. BROWN: Oh yes, I'm sorry. I'm
21 actually in a training course. Is this my case
22 for Lidl?

23 (Laughter.)

24 MS. FLETCHER: Yeah. This is your
25 case, yes.

1 MS. BROWN: Okay. Yes, let me turn my
2 camera on. Okay, can you see -- okay. Tiffany
3 Brown --

4 MS. FLETCHER: There she is.

5 MS. BROWN: There I am. Tiffany
6 Brown, Commissioner, ANC 7B02 and Chair of ANC
7 7B.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Brown.
9 ANC 7B does have standing as a Protestant, we
10 need to set a date for a mediation, a status
11 hearing, and a protest hearing.

12 I'll give you the dates for the status
13 and protest hearing first, the status hearing is
14 set for September 28, 2022 at 10:30 a.m..

15 MS. BROWN: September 28, what day of
16 the week is that?

17 MS. FLETCHER: That's going to be a
18 Wednesday -- yeah, a Wednesday.

19 MS. BROWN: That's fine, I think --
20 that's fine for that. Can we get to a mediation
21 date because I think we probably can -- won't
22 need the status hearing.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Well, you know, I'll
24 give you the date for the protest hearing just
25 because I have to.

1 MS. BROWN: Okay.

2 MS. FLETCHER: And the protest hearing
3 is set for October 26, 2022 at 1:30, and Ms.
4 Brown, I will give you the next available day for
5 mediation.

6 MS. BROWN: Okay.

7 MS. FLETCHER: The next available day
8 is Tuesday, August 9, anytime --

9 MS. BROWN: Tuesday --

10 MS. FLETCHER: Uh-huh?

11 MS. BROWN: No, I'm sorry, I'm looking
12 -- that's fine.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Is that good for you,
14 Ms. Mahmoud?

15 MS. MAHMOUD: Yes. Thank you so much,
16 Ms. Fletcher.

17 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. And
18 what about 11:00 o'clock on August 9?

19 MS. MAHMOUD: Is there anything in the
20 afternoon?

21 MS. FLETCHER: Yes, we can do it at
22 1:30.

23 MS. MAHMOUD: Ms. Brown, if that works
24 for you, that'd be great.

25 MS. BROWN: That works for me, my

1 whole day is clear. Yep, I can do 1:00 o'clock.

2 MS. MAHMOUD: Thank you so much,
3 Commissioner.

4 MS. FLETCHER: A mediation is set for
5 Tuesday, August 9, at 1:30. I'll see you then.

6 MS. MAHMOUD: Thank you so much, Ms.
7 Fletcher.

8 MS. BROWN: Thank you.

9 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. Until
10 then.

11 MS. BROWN: Okay, thanks.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you very
13 much.

14 MS. MAHMOUD: Thank you. Bye.

15 MS. BROWN: Bye.

16 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. The
17 roll call hearing is concluded. Thank you.

18 Is there anyone else who's present
19 that I need to talk to? So, Mr. Ready?

20 MR. READY: Oh yes, I'm sorry?

21 MS. FLETCHER: You don't need me for
22 anything, do you?

23 MR. READY: No, I just wanted to make
24 sure, on the last time, I'm here for everything,
25 just so there's no problems.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, well then we're
3 done for the day. Thanks again, Mr. Ready, for
4 coming. The --

5 MR. READY: All right. Thank you.

6 MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.

9 much, you have a wonderful day.

10 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome, you do
11 the same. Thank you.
