The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met via WebEx videoconference, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

MS. FLETCHER: I am calling the case of BHG Waterfront, LLC, trading as to be determined, 715 Wharf Street, NW, License Number ABRA-118143. This is a Retailer Class CT new application. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet. Present on behalf of the applicant?

MS. YOHANNES: Hello. Sidon Yohannes on behalf of the applicant, and that's S-I-D-O-N, Y-O-H-A-N-N-E-S.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms.
Yohannes. Is the applicant present today?
MS. YOHANNES: No, he's not.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you. And who is present on behalf of the Group of $12 ?$

MR. SCHLOSSMAN: That would be me, Joshua Mikhael Schlossman.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. If you would just state your name one more time and spell it for the record?

MR. SCHLOSSMAN: Sure. Joshua Mikhael Schlossman. It's Joshua, J-O-S-H-U-A, Mikhael, M-I-K-H-A-E-L, Schlossman, S-C-H-L-O-S-S as in Sam-

M-A-N.
MS. FLETCHER: And Mr. Schlossman, are there any other members from your group present today?

MR. SCHLOSSMAN: Yes. I have Karen Anderson, Martin Welles, Laura Zylstra, Todd Garth, Dalton Williams. I also have on the phone at least one other.

MS. FLETCHER: If those individuals would state their names and spell them for the record, please? We can start with Karen Anderson.

MS. ANDERSON: Sorry about that. Karen Anderson, K-A-R-E-N, last name A-N-D-E-R-S-O-N.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms.
Anderson. And there -- and someone else.
There's a few other people?
(Simultaneous speaking.)
MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Welles?
(Audio interference.)
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Ms. Zylstra, I think you're trying to speak but you're breaking up right now. You want to try again? Okay. Laura -- Mr. Schlossman, is Laura Zylstra part of
your group?
MR. SCHLOSSMAN: Yes, she is and the name that (simultaneous speaking) --

MS. ZYLSTRA: Yeah, Laura Zylstra -(Simultaneous speaking.)

MS. ZYLSTRA: Yes. Laura Zylstra. It's Z as in Zebra-Y-S as in Sam.

MS. FLETCHER: And so Ms. Zylstra, you're breaking up. I'm going to spell your name for the court reporter. I have it spelled as L-A-U-R-A, Z like Zebra-Y-L-S-T-R-A. If that's incorrect --

MS. ZYLSTRA: Correct.
MS. FLETCHER: Is that correct? Okay. Good. Okay. Mr. Welles --

MS. ZYLSTRA: Yes. Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: -- you can go ahead.
MR. WELLES: Good morning. My name is Martin Welles, M-A-R-T-I-N, W-E-L-L-E-S.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Welles. And the next person?

MR. GARTH: Hi. My name is Todd Garth, and my name is spelled T-O-D-D, G-A-R-T-H.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. Anyone else from a Group of 12?

MS. ROWLAND: My name is Clare Rowland, C-L-A-R-E, R-O-W-L-A-N-D.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Rowland. Anyone else?

MR. WILLIAMS: Dalton Williams, D-A-L-T-O-N, Williams, W-I-L-L-I-A-M-S.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Anyone else?
(No audible response.)
MS. FLETCHER: Seven individuals -I've counted seven individuals present from the Group of 12 , which means that the Group of 12 is granted full standing as a protestant. Mr. Schlossman, you and Ms. Anderson are the designated representatives for the group; is that correct?

MR. SCHLOSSMAN: That's correct, we're the designated representatives for the group.

MS. FLETCHER: Well, what that means is that at the upcoming status hearing, either one of you may appear -- either one of you may appear, just either one of you. The rest of the members of the group do not need to appear.

MR. SCHLOSSMAN: Perfect. Thank you. MS. FLETCHER: And -- you're welcome.

And present on behalf of ANC 6D?
MR. DANIELS: Good morning, Ms.
Fletcher. My name is Edward Daniels, E-D-W-A-RD, D-A-N-I-E-L-S, and I am the Chair of ANC 6D.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Daniels.
ANC 6D does have standing as a protestant. We're going to need to set some dates now for a mediation, status hearing, and I'll check the availability of the protest hearing date for you. I'm going to have to place you on hold for just a second. I'm going to disappear for a moment. I'll be right back. Thank you.
(Pause.)
MS. FLETCHER: I'm still here, be right with you.
(Pause.)
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So I'm going to give you the date for your status hearing and your protest hearing. The day for the status hearing is August 18 at 10:30 a.m. That's August 18 at 10:30 a.m. for the status hearing. The protest hearing is set for October 6 at 1:30 p.m. That's October 6 at 1:30 p.m. for the protest hearing. And you'll receive WebEx invitations for those hearings as well.

We need to set a date for mediation. Ideally, it will occur before the 18th of August. I'll give you the next available day for mediation. The next available day is Tuesday, August 10, pretty much anytime between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., so that can be actually, 10:00, 11:00, 12:00, anytime between 10:00 and 2:00.

MS. YOHANNES: I'm available 11:00 to 1:00 on Tuesday.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Mr. Schlossman or Ms. Anderson, are you available on August 10?

MR. SCHLOSSMAN: I'm checking my calendar now.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
MR. SCHLOSSMAN: Let's see, I am available at 11:00 Eastern Time.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. What -- Mr. Daniels, what about you?

MR. DANIELS: I'm actually available all day that day, so anytime that works for everyone else.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, that's perfect. We can set the mediation then for Tuesday, August 10 at 11:00 a.m., and you'll see a WebEx invitation from me to attend the
mediation. Any questions at all?
MR. WELLES: Ms. Fletcher, $I$ have a question. Martin Welles here. Is anybody invited to the mediation, or is that just the points --

MS. FLETCHER: Well, normally -- Mr. Welles, normally, the designated representative appears but you're welcome to attend because you are a protestant. It's -- normally, it's the designated representative but it's up to you. If you decide you're going to come, let me know so I can send you an invitation. Otherwise, the invitations would go to the two designated representatives, Mr. Schlossman and Ms. Anderson.

MR. WELLES: Thank you. Let me check with my designated reps and we'll make a decision.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Just let me know. Okay.

MR. WILLIAMS: This is Dalton Williams. If you'd include me in that, I'd appreciate it.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, Mr. Williams. I just made a note to send you an invitation to the mediation.

MR. WILLIAMS: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.
MS. YOHANNES: I just wanted to make one comment. Ms. Fletcher, if you could advise the parties about entering a settlement agreement prior to the mediation, what that would do to the mediation date.

MS. FLETCHER: Yes. If the parties are able to enter into a settlement agreement prior to the mediation date, then we can cancel the mediation. If the parties submit a settlement agreement prior to the status hearing, we'll cancel the status hearing. And if the Board approves the settlement agreement, then we'll cancel the protest hearing as well.

One other thing I'll mention, because this is a protest filed by the ANC in addition to a Group of 12 , if the ANC enters into a settlement agreement, then the ABC Board dismisses the Group of 12 and ideally, a settlement agreement entered into with the ANC will include the interest of the community. But we're not there yet. That's just for your information. The mediation will include the Group of 12 and ANC 6D.

MS. YOHANNES: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.
Anybody else have any questions at all?
(No audible response.)
MS. FLETCHER: Well, thank you for coming. The roll call hearing is concluded in the matter of BHG, and I'll call the next case. (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter went off the record at 10:16 a.m.)
