7 Ms. Fashbaugh, can you please elevate
8 the rights of the parties in this case, please?

9 MS. FASHBAUGH: Please stand by.
10 Chairperson Edward Daniels, your rights have been
11 elevated; and, Sidon Yohannes, your rights have
12 been elevated.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. Ms.
14 Yohannes, good morning.

15 MS. YOHANNES: Good morning.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.
17 Can you please spell and state your name for the
18 record and your representation?

19 MS. YOHANNES: Sidon Yohannes on behalf
20 of the applicant. S-I-D-O-N, Y-O-H-A-N-N-E-S.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.
22 Good morning, Mr. Daniels. Can you please spell
23 and state your name for the record and your
24 representation, sir?

25 MR. DANIELS: Yes. Good morning,

1 everyone. My name is Edward Daniels representing
2 ANC 6D. That's Edward, E-D-W-A-R-D, Daniels, D-
3 A-N-I-E-L-S.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
5 sir.

6 MR. DANIELS: And I apologize for the
7 shadowy setting here.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well, you're
9 fine, sir. The only difference is that I pull
10 away a little bit from the camera --

11 MR. DANIELS: I know.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: -- so we can
13 see your face clearly.

14 MR. DANIELS: Yes.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

17 preliminary matters in this case, please?

18 MS. YOHANNES: None for the applicant.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And, Mr.
20 Daniels, are there any preliminary matters in
21 this case, sir?

22 MR. DANIELS: No.

23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
24 Then this matter is scheduled for a protest
25 hearing on September 21st, 2022 at 1:30 p.m. Do

1 the parties wish for me to review the
2 instructions for a protest hearing?

3 MS. YOHANNES: No, I think we are fine.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

5 MR. DANIELS: And I'm fine.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I just want to
7 remind you seven days before the hearing that the
8 parties are required to, if this matter goes to a
9 protest hearing, that seven days before the
10 hearing the parties are required to exchange
11 documents and witnesses. And these exchanges are
12 between the parties, and ABRA legal should also
13 be provided a copy. And each side will have no
14 more than five witnesses, and you have 60 minutes
15 to present your case.

16 If the parties are able to settle this
17 matter, the Board supports settlement, so we look
18 forward to that. If not, we will see you on
19 September 21st at 1:30 p.m.
