24 is as follows.

25 Charge 1, sale of an alcoholic

1 beverage to a person under 21 years of age,
2 statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-781.
3 There is a fine of \$2,000 to be paid within 60
4 days or the license will be suspended until the
5 fine has been paid.

6 Term 2, suspension, the license shall
7 be suspended for five days with all five days
8 stayed for one year pending completion of alcohol
9 awareness training for all employees who serve
10 alcoholic beverages within 90 days from the
11 acceptance of this offer in compromise.

12 Charge 2, failure to take reasonable
13 steps necessary to ascertain legal drinking age,
14 statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-783.
15 There is a fine of \$1,000 to be paid within 60
16 days or the license will be suspended until the
17 fine has been paid.

18 That is the OIC. Is there a second?

19 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. I second.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has

18 There shall be failure to comply with
19 Mayor's order and Board's emergency rulemaking,
20 statutory authority 23 DCMR Section 810.2 and
21 D.C. Code Section 25-82381.

22 There is a fine of \$1,000 payable
23 within 120 days of the Board's acceptance of the
24 OIC. And if payment is not made within 120 days,
25 the license shall be suspended until the fine has

1 been paid.

2 I, therefore, make a motion that we
3 accept this offer in compromise. Is there a
4 second?

5 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. I second.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
7 seconded the motion. And we will now have a roll

6 00022 and for Case No. 19-25100107.

7 Yes, so for Case No. 19-CMP-00022, the
8 charge was increased interior occupancy,
9 statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-82387.
10 That case will be dismissed.

11 For Case No. 19-25100107, charge 1,
12 interference with an investigation, statutory
13 authority D.C. Code Section 25-82385. There is a
14 fine of \$2,500 payable within 120 days or the
15 license will be suspended until the fine has been
16 paid.

17 That is the offer in compromise for
18 both cases. I make a motion that we accept the
19 offer in compromise. Is there a second?
