3	MS. FLETCHER: The last case on the
4	calendar for today is The Avery. This is case
5	no. 22-PRO-00082, TBC P Street Hotel, LLC, 2616 P
6	Street NW, license no. ABRA 121441. This is
7	retailer class C bed and breakfast. It is a new
8	application. The protest issues are adverse
9	impact on peace, order, and quiet. My name is
10	Laverne Fletcher conducting a roll call hearing
11	as the Board's agent. Who is present on behalf
12	of the Applicant?
13	MS. LUND: My name is Mahkbuba Lund.
14	MS. FLETCHER: You're representing The
15	Avery?
16	MS. LUND: No. I'm sorry.
17	MS. FLETCHER: Who is present on
18	behalf of The Avery?
19	MS. YOHANNES: Good morning. Sidon
20	Yohannes on behalf of The Avery. That is S-I-D-
21	O-N Y-O-H-A-N-N-E-S.
22	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And who is
23	present on behalf of ANC 2E?
24	MS. LOHSE: Commissioner Gwendolyn
25	Lohse. That's L-O-H-S-E, and I'm in ANC 2E06

where the applicant resides. 1 2 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Lohse, 3 can you spell your first name for the record, 4 please? 5 Gwendolyn, G-W-E-N-MS. LOHSE: Yes. D-O-L-Y-N. 6 7 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And present on behalf of the Citizen's Association of 8 9 Georgetown? 10 MS. CRUSE: Good morning. I'm Karen 11 Cruse. 12 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Cruse. 13 Ms. Cruse, would you please spell your name? 14 MS. CRUSE: Yes. Karen, K-A-R-E-N, 15 Cruse, C-R-U-S-E. We have 16 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. 17 several groups of individuals. We have a group 18 of six. Is there anyone present by the name of, 19 well the last name is L-U-N-D, Lund? 20 MS. LUND: Correct. Yes. 21 Ms. Lund, what is your MS. FLETCHER: 22 telephone number? 347-530-7992. 23 MS. LUND: 24 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So, that's your 25 telephone number I see there. Would you please

spell your name and state it for the record? 1 2 MS. LUND: Makhbuba, A-K-H-B-U-B-A. 3 MS. FLETCHER: And can you spell your 4 last name, please? 5 MS. LUND: L-U-N-D. MS. FLETCHER: Are there any other 6 7 members present from your group today? 8 MS. LUND: Yes. One moment. 9 MR. STOUT: Yes, Robert and Beverly 10 Stout, R-O-B-E-R-T S-T-O-U-T. 11 Thank you. MS. FLETCHER: Anyone 12 else? 13 MR. STOUT: And my wife Beverly, B-E-14 V-E-R-L-Y S-T-O-U-T. 15 Is Beverly present? MS. FLETCHER: 16 MR. STOUT: Yes. 17 MS. STOUT: Yes, I am. 18 MS. FLETCHER: Anyone else? 19 MS. LUND: Just one moment. Robert and Linda Yahn. 20 MR. YAHN: The 21 last name is spelled Y-A-H-N. First name Robert, 22 R-O-B-E-R-T. And Linda, my wife, L-I-N-D-A. 23 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Is Linda 24 present today? 25 MR. YAHN: Yes, she is.

1 MS. YAHN: Yes, I am. 2 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Linda. 3 Everyone present signed the protest letter, yes? 4 MR. YAHN: Yes. 5 MR. STOUT: Yes. MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Anyone 6 7 else? Is there anyone else present from this 8 group? 9 MR. HETEM: This is Robert Hetem. 10 We're in a different group. 11 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Hetem, I haven't 12 called your group yet. 13 MR. HETEM: Okay. Thank you. 14 MS. FLETCHER: I'll spell your name, 15 since you said it, it's H-E-T-E-M. I'll call Mr. 16 Hetem's group in a moment. Thank you. 17 MR. HETEM: Thank you. You're welcome. 18 MS. FLETCHER: Ms. 19 Lund, there are five individuals present from y 20 our group today, which means that your group is 21 granted standing as a Protestant. 22 MS. LUND: Also, my husband is not 23 here at the moment. 24 It's okay. There are MS. FLETCHER: 25 five of you present. If he shows up we'll add

him, but there are five of you present. 1 2 MS. LUND: That's correct, yes. 3 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you. If 4 he shows up we will add him. 5 MS. LUND: Okay. Thank you. MR. ABRAMS: Ms. Fletcher, just for 6 7 the record. My name is David Abrams. I just 8 joined in. 9 MS. FLETCHER: Excuse me. MR. ABRAMS: David Abrams. 10 11 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Mr. Abrams, 12 you're with Mr. Hetem's group, aren't you? MR. ABRAMS: I'm with Ms. Lohse. 13 Ι 14 had filed a protest letter. 15 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So, let me be 16 clear about something here. Mr. Abrams, you 17 filed the protest right? 18 MR. ABRAMS: Correct. 19 MS. FLETCHER: You're saying that 20 you're here with ANC 2E? 21 MR. ABRAMS: Well, I'm here with the 22 group that's protesting the application. 23 MS. FLETCHER: That's what I thought. 24 You're with a group of individuals. 25 MR. ABRAMS: Yes, ma'am.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So, I'll call 1 2 your case in a moment. 3 MR. ABRAMS: Okay. I'm just here as 4 an observer. I'm not going to say anything 5 during the meeting. MS. FLETCHER: That's okay. You filed 6 7 the protest. I've got your protest in the 8 protest file. I'm only noting for clarity for 9 the court reporter that Mr. Abrams is not a part of this case. I have not called Mr. Abrams case 10 11 yet. Mr. Abrams, because you're speaking, can 12 you spell your name for the record, please? 13 MR. ABRAMS: Sure. David, and the 14 last name is Abrams, A-B-R-A-M-S. 15 Thank you, very much. MS. FLETCHER: 16 MR. ABRAMS: Thank you. 17 MS. FLETCHER: So, Ms. Lund, just to 18 recap, your group of six has been granted 19 standing as Protestants because at least five of 20 you are present today. 21 MS. LUND: Thank you. 22 MS. FLETCHER: We also have a group of 23 seven represented by Mr. Hetem. Mr. Hetem, are 24 you present? Is Mr. Hetem present? 25 Yes, Robert Hetem. MR. HETEM:

1 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Mr. Hetem, your 2 telephone number ends in 11? 3 MR. HETEM: Yes. 4 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Would you 5 please spell your name for the record? MR. HETEM: R-O-B-E-R-T, last name 6 7 Hetem, H-E-T-E-M. 8 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Is anyone 9 else present from your group today? 10 MS. ZIMMER: Yes. If you could just state 11 MS. FLETCHER: 12 your name and spell it for the record, please. 13 MS. ZIMMER: Yes. It's Constance 14 Zimmer, C-O-N-S-T-A-N-C-E Z-I-M-M-E-R. 15 MS. FLETCHER: D-I? 16 MS. ZIMMER: Z-I-M-M-E-R. 17 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Anyone 18 else? Anyone else present from the group 19 represented by Mr. Hetem? MR. HETEM: I think David Abrams is in 20 21 our group. 22 MR. ABRAMS: Yes. 23 MS. FLETCHER: Yes, I know. Mr. 24 Abrams could you state your name and spell it for 25 the record, please?

1	MR. ABRAMS: It's David Abrams, A-B-R-
2	A-M-S.
3	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Anyone else
4	from Mr. Hetem's group? Okay. Mr. Hetem.
5	MR. HETEM: Yes.
6	MS. FLETCHER: There are three members
7	present from your group today, which means that
8	your group is granted conditional standing, which
9	means that at the upcoming status hearing two
10	more people will need to appear for the status
11	hearing who are not present today. At that time,
12	the Board will grant full standing to your group.
13	The Board needs to see at least five people in
14	person, so to speak, three of you are present
15	today, two more will need to appear for the
16	upcoming status hearing. If two more additional
17	people do not appear for the upcoming status
18	hearing, the Board may dismiss your protest, so
19	just bring the two additional people for the
20	status hearing. Any questions about that?
21	MR. HETEM: We will do that. No.
22	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Your group
23	of seven is granted conditional standing.
24	MS. CRUSE: Ms. Fletcher, may I butt
25	in for a minute. This is Karen Cruse.

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1	MS. FLETCHER: Yes, Ms. Cruse.
2	MS. CRUSE: I'm not so sure if all the
3	Protestants, since they haven't done this before,
4	are aware of the process, but Mr. Hetem and his
5	wife have identified themselves, I had thought,
6	as abutting neighbors, which, obviously, puts
7	them into a different category as well. Could
8	you check and verify that?
9	MS. FLETCHER: Let me check that. I
10	didn't see that. Let me see if they included
11	that in the protest letter, Ms. Cruse. Mr.
12	Hetem, did your protest include that you consider
13	yourself to be an abutting property owner?
14	MR. HETEM: Yes, definitely.
15	MS. FLETCHER: I am looking at your
16	protest letter, Mr. Hetem, just a minute, please.
17	MS. YOHANNES: This is Sidon Yohannes,
18	just for the record, I just want to note that I
19	don't see a reference to the Protestant
20	indicating that they want to protest as an
21	abutting property owner. So, if it is here I'd
22	like I could be directed as to where.
23	MS. FLETCHER: I don't see it yet.
24	I'm just double checking.
25	MS. YOHANNES: Sure.
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I'm just double 1 MS. FLETCHER: 2 checking to make sure I'm not missing anything 3 here. I didn't see it earlier. So, Mr. Hetem, 4 you thought you included in your protest letter 5 that you were filing as an abutting property owner? 6 7 MR. HETEM: Yes. 8 MS. FLETCHER: I don't see it. The 9 protest letter that I have for you is the one 10 that you signed along with Ms. Zimmer, Z-I-M-M-E-11 Is that the protest letter that you're R. 12 referring to? MR. HETEM: We have a bad connection. 13 14 MS. FLETCHER: Say that again, Mr. 15 Hetem. 16 MR. HETEM: We have a bad connection. 17 I'm sorry. 18 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So, I'm not 19 going to grant standing to Mr. Hetem as an 20 abutting property owner because I don't see that 21 protest letter. If that turns out to be the 22 case, we'll address it at a different time. For 23 the purpose of the roll call hearing today Mr. 24 Hetem is not considered an abutting property 25 owner, but he is the designated represented. As

Neal R. Gross and Co., Inc. Washington DC a group of seven he is a Protestant representing
a group of seven.

Thank you, Ms. Cruse. I didn't find it in the file, so that's what I'm going to have to go with today.

We have one more Protestant in this 6 7 Is there someone here from the Jerusalem matter. 8 Baptist Church? There's no one present from the 9 Jerusalem Baptist Church. So, they're actually 10 dismissed for two reasons, they're not present, 11 but churches do not have standings as 12 Protestants, and so, the Jerusalem Baptist Church is dismissed. 13

14 For The Avery we have as Protestants 15 ANC 2E granted standing. The Citizen's 16 Association of Georgetown granted standing. The 17 group of six represented by Ms. Lund, L-U-N-D, is 18 granted standing. The group of seven represented 19 by Mr. Hetem, H-E-T-E-M, is granted conditional 20 standing because three members from their group 21 are present today and two more need to appear at 22 the upcoming status hearing. The Jerusalem Baptist Church is dismissed because churches do 23 24 not have standing, and they are not present 25 today.

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We need to set a date for status 1 2 hearing, protest hearing, and a mediation. I'm 3 going to give you the date for the status and 4 protest hearing first. The status hearing is set 5 for September 14 at 10:30 a.m. September 14 at 6 10:30 a.m. for the status hearing. The protest 7 hearing is set for October 5. October 5 at 1:30 8 I'll give you the next available date for p.m. 9 mediation. The next available day is Tuesday, 10 August 23 at 10:00 or 11:00 a.m. 11 MS. LOHSE: This is Commissioner 12 Lohse. We will probably need another date because several of the Protestants will be out of 13 14 town at that date, and we are working, we are 15 meeting all the abutting neighbors, ANC, and CAG 16 have met in person with the Applicant to discuss 17 potential terms, so we would like more time 18 before we have a mediation anyway. 19 MS. FLETCHER: What about Wednesday, September 7 at 10:00 or 11:00? Does that work 20 21 for you, Ms. Lohse? 22 MS. LOHSE: I think people should be 23 back then, and we'll also have time to meet with 24 the Applicant at that point, so we can check in 25 with you at that date.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Yohannes, does that 2 work for you? 3 MS. YOHANNES: Yes, that's fine. 4 September 7 at 11:00 a.m.? 5 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. MS. YOHANNES: Okay. 6 Yes. 7 MS. FLETCHER: Mediation is set for 8 Wednesday, September 7 at 11:00. Just to 9 clarify, Ms. Lohse, there are no abutting 10 property owners, but you're saying that you and 11 all of the individual Protestants have met with 12 the establishment and that you're going to 13 continue your efforts to try to resolve this matter before mediation? 14 15 MS. LOHSE: Correct. Yes. 16 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. You've got the 17 We've got mediation set. If the matter dates. is resolved before mediation you can just let us 18 19 know and we'll cancel it as well as the status 20 and protest hearing. 21 Thank you. MS. YOHANNES: 22 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. Any 23 questions anybody? 24 MS. CRUSE: It might be moot, but if 25 the abutting neighbors, of which there were

several, find the documentation that they had 1 2 indicated that they were actually abutting 3 neighbors, what would be the procedure for them 4 to get it back before you? 5 MS. FLETCHER: If they filed as abutting property owners before the petition 6 7 deadline, which was July. The petition deadline 8 to file a protest was July 18, 2022. If anyone 9 filed a protest claiming to be abutting prior to the petition deadline then we would have to take 10 11 that into consideration, but the protest letter 12 would've needed to have been submitted prior to 13 September 18. I didn't see it in the file, but, 14 you know, things happen. If that's available, 15 we'll make the necessary correction. 16 MS. CRUSE: Okay. Thank you. 17 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome, Ms. 18 Cruse. Anybody else? 19 MS. YOHANNES: Nothing for the 20 Applicant. 21 MS. FLETCHER: I want to thank 22 everybody for coming. See you soon, or not. Let 23 us know. The roll call hearing is concluded. 24 (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter 25 went off the record at 10:59 a.m.)

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
