3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case  
4 on our calendar is Case Number 22-PRO-00057, We,  
5 The Pizza, license number 82062. Mr. Oriana  
6 (Phonetic.), can you please elevate the rights of  
7 the protestant in this case? Oh, I guess it's  
8 also (Simultaneous speaking.) license 6B. I knew  
9 that was Mr. Jackson, I didn't look to see --

10 MR. JACKSON: Yes.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: That it was the  
12 same ANC. I think that -- Mr. Ready, I see that  
13 you're here and I think Mr. Jayaraman he left so  
14 I guess he's not participating in that one? All  
15 right (Simultaneous speaking.) Yes?

16 MR. JACKSON: He said elevate him as  
17 well.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Oriana, can  
19 you please elevate the rights back of Mr.  
20 Jayaraman, since he left the screen?

21 MR. ORIANA: Mr. Jayaraman, you've  
22 been elevated.

23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, good  
24 morning.

25 MR. JAYARAMAN: Thanks very much.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Could the  
2 parties please identify themselves for the record  
3 starting with the licensee please?

4 MR. JACKSON: Yes, Jeff Jackson for  
5 the Applicant.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,  
7 Mr. Jackson. Mr. Ready, can you please spell and  
8 state your name for the record?

9 MR. READY: Brian Ready for ANC 6B,  
10 name B-R-I-A-N last name Ready R-E-A-D-Y.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jayaraman,  
12 can you please identify yourself for the record,  
13 please?

14 MR. JAYARAMAN: Chander Jayaraman  
15 first name spelled C-H-A-N-D-E-R last name J-A-Y-  
16 A-R-A-M-A-N. I am the co-chair of ANC 6B's  
17 Alcohol Beverage Committee and one of the  
18 designated representatives of ANC 6B on these  
19 matters.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,  
21 sir. Good morning, welcome. All right everyone.  
22 Are there any preliminary matters in this case,  
23 Mr. Jackson?

24 MR. JACKSON: No, not to my knowledge.  
25 We're in the process of working on the settlement

1 agreement.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Have we had a  
3 mediation as yet on this case?

4 MR. READY: No.

5 MR. JACKSON: No, sir.

6 MR. READY: No, we have not.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right,  
8 okay, so I think the agency will go and schedule  
9 the mediation in this case. All right, any other  
10 preliminary matter from the ANC?

11 MR. READY: Nothing I'm aware of.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right,  
13 fine. All right, then this matter is scheduled  
14 for a protest hearing on September 21st, 2022 at  
15 1:30 p.m. As the first case, the agency will  
16 move forward and schedule a mediation.

17 If the parties believe that this  
18 matter can be settled short of a protest hearing  
19 on September 21, 2022, then the matter can be  
20 resolved. If you have a successful mediation and  
21 you really believe that you need some more time,  
22 parties can jointly request that the protest  
23 hearing that's scheduled for September 21, 2022  
24 at 1:30 be scheduled until a further status  
25 hearing.

1           But I just want to remind the parties,  
2           if this matter is going to be a protest hearing  
3           on the 21st, then seven days prior to the hearing  
4           you must exchange documents or witnesses with the  
5           other side and also with the agency.

6           Just also to remind the parties that  
7           because these hearings are now held virtually,  
8           each side is limited to 60 minutes to present  
9           their case and you are allowed to have five  
10          witnesses, if we're going to move forward with a  
11          protest hearing on September 21st, 2022. But,  
12          the agency will move forward in scheduling a  
13          mediation and good luck in your mediation and  
14          have a great summer and have a great day. Thank  
15          you for being here this morning.

16                 MR. READY: Thank you.

17                 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you very  
18          much. All right then.

19                 MR. JACKSON: Thank you.

20                 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. You  
21          can log off, Mr. Jackson, if you so desire.

22                 MR. JACKSON: Okay.

23                 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.

24                 (Whereupon, the proceeding went off  
25          the record at 10:53 a.m.)
