3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the
4 calendar is Fish Shop DC, case number 24-PRO-
5 00082, Artfarm DC Inc., 610 Water Street
6 Southwest, license number ABRA-128628. This is a
7 Retailer Class CR for a New Application. The
8 protest issues are adverse impact on peace,
9 order, and quiet.

10 My name is LaVerne Fletcher,
11 conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's
12 agent. Is anyone present on behalf of Fish Shop
13 DC?

14 MR. MIXON: Yes, I'm also counsel to
15 this one. Cameron Mixon, Veritas Law Firm.
16 Cameron, C-A-M-E-R-O-N. Mixon, M I-X-O-N.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Mixon.
18 Anyone present on behalf of ANC 6D?

19 MR. LINK: Good morning, Ms. Fletcher.
20 Bob Link, ANC 6D. B-O-B, L-I-N-K.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Link.
22 ANC 6D does have standing as a protestant. We
23 need to set a date for mediation, a status
24 hearing, and a protest hearing.

2 hearing is set for September 18, 2024 at 10:30
3 a.m. The protest hearing is set for October 2,
4 2024 at 1:30 p.m. I will give you the next
5 available day for mediation. One second here.
6 The next available day for mediation is
7 Wednesday, August 28 at 1:30 in the afternoon.

9 MR. MIXON: -- work for the Applicant,
10 yes.

11 MS. FLETCHER: That works for the
12 Applicant, Mr. Mixon?

13 MR. MIXON: Yes, ma'am.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Link, does that
15 work for you?

16 MR. LINK: It works for me. But we're
17 well underway, so hopefully we won't need it.

18 MS. FLETCHER: Yeah, I made a note of
19 that. Thank you very much.
