CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The Board has 19 four members in attendance on account of business 20 21 today and that constitutes a quorum. 2.2 Before we get underway with the 23 hearing calendar I need to make a few 2.4 instructions are clear so that the conduct of 25 these hearings is understood by everyone.

There are seven cases scheduled for this morning's calendar. Once your case is called, I will take a moment for the IT Specialist to elevate the rights for each party to enable their camera and microphone. Then and only then will you have the ability to enable your equipment.

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1 MR. CARTER: Candace Fitch has been 2 elevated and Edward Daniels has been elevated. 3 That's all. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. 4 5 Good morning. Ms. Fitch, can you 6 please spell and state your name and identify 7 yourself for the record, please. 8 MS. FITCH: My name is Candace Fitch, 9 F-I-T-C-H. I am the attorney for the Applicant. 10 Ms. Fitch, is the Applicant going to be here this 11 morning? 12 MS. FITCH: He has emailed me that 13 he's been trying to call in and he not having any 14 success. So --15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Does he 16 have the log-in information if not we can put that information or if you tell us the last four 17 18 digits of his phone number I will ask the IT 19 person to look for him on the phone, on the call-20 in log. 21 MS. FITCH: I apologize. I'm trying So, does he have the 2.2 to find his phone number. 23 call-in information? Yes. I sent it to him and 2.4 MS. FITCH: 25 he confirmed that he received it and he said he's

10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. But	
11	I'm saying is he on the phone or is he on the	
12	MS. FITCH: He says he's calling in on	
13	his phone and he says he's in and muted. So, you

Can you identify yourself for the 3 record, please. 4 5 The individual on the phone can you unmute your line and please identify yourself for 6 7 the record? 8 Mr. Carter, have you unmuted that 9 person's line? MR. CARTER: Yes, it's unmuted. 10 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Then they have 12 to unmute themself because I see that they're 13 still muted. Can you find out, Ms. Finch. We have 14 elevated a 401 number. If that's his number he 15 16 needs to, he should be able to participate. owner should be able to participate if they're 17 18 number is a 401. 19 Can you identify yourself for the 20 record, please, sir. 21 MR. RYAN: It's Steven Ryan. 2.2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And who are you, 23 sir? MR. RYAN: I'm the owner/representative 2.4 25 of the Applicant.

12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.	
13	Ms. Fitch, are there any preliminary	
14	matters in this case?	
15	MS. FITCH: I have none.	
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Daniels, do	
17	you have any preliminary matters, sir?	
18	MR. DANIELS: No.	
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: This matter then	
20	is scheduled for, if this matter is not settled,	
21	it's scheduled for a Protest Hearing on September	
22	13 at 1:30 p.m.	
23	Are the parties aware of if this	
24	matter goes to a Protest Hearing what needs to be	
25	done in the sense of you have to do a PIP. The	

1 PIP is due seven days before the hearing. 2 Failure by either side to provide a PIP you will 3 be unless good cause is shown, you will be prevented from relying on documents and witnesses 4 5 that have not been disclosed seven days before 6 the hearing. 7 Also, if this matter goes to the 8 hearing, each side will have one hour to 9 represent their case and you'll have no more than, you can only call five witnesses. 10 Are 11 there any questions by any side? 12 MR. RYAN: No, thank you. 13 MS. FITCH: I have no questions. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 15 Board supports settlement. If this matter can be 16 settled, we support the parties continuing to talk to see if this matter can be settled. 17 18 this matter is not settled, then we will see you 19 at a Protest Hearing on September 13th at 1:30 20 p.m.
