3	MS. FLETCHER: Good morning, everybody	
4	I'd like to thank you all for joining ABRA's roll	
5	call hearing being provided via WebEx, provided	
6	by the D.C. Office of Open Government.	
7	My name is Laverne Fletcher, I'll be	
8	conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's	
9	Agent. I am calling the matter of Park Market,	
10	this is Case Number 21-PRO-00064 S & G Inc., 3400	
11	13th Street NW, License Number ABR8094178.	
12	This is a retailer Class A license	
13	renewal. The protest issues are adverse impact	
14	on peace order and quiet. Who is present on	
15	behalf of the Applicant?	
16	MR. JACKSON: Jeff Jackson	
17	representing the Applicant.	
18	MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Jackson, would you	
19	please spell your name for the record?	
20	MR. JACKSON: J-E-F-F, Jackson, J-A-C-	
21	K-S-O-N.	
22	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much, is	
23	the Applicant present?	
24	MR. KAHASSAI: Yes, I believe so.	
25	MS. FLETCHER: Is that Mr. Kahassai?	

1	MR. KAHASSAI: Yes.	
2	MS. FLETCHER: Are you present?	
3	MR. KAHASSAI: Yes.	
4	MS. FLETCHER: Would you please state	
5	your name and spell it for the record?	
6	MR. KAHASSAI: First name G-E-B-R-E,	
7	last name, K-A-H-A-S-S-A-I.	
8	MS. FLETCHER: thank you very much.	
9	I will also have a group of eight protestants.	
10	Is Marsha Livingston present, the designated	
11	representative?	
12	MR. MALMO: This is Jerry Malmo, I'm	
13	here representing the protestant.	
14	MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Malmo, would you	
15	please spell your name for the record?	
16	MR. MALMO: Jerry with a J, J-E-R-Y,	
17	Malmo, M-A-L-M-O.	
18	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. Is	
19	anyone else present from the group of eight? I	
20	see the name of Antarah Crawley, Ms. Crawley are	
21	you a member of the group of eight?	
22	Thank you. Is there anyone else	
23	present from the group of eight? Mr. Malmo, are	
24	you representing the group this morning?	
25	MR. MALMO: That's correct.	

That's fine, your group 1 MS. FLETCHER: 2 is granted conditional standing. The Board needs 3 to see at least five people at the upcoming status hearing. You'll need to bring at least 4 5 four individuals who weren't present today in order to be granted full standing as a protesting 6 7 group. 8 If those four people do not appear, 9 the Board may dismiss the protest but we'll 10 proceed today with your group being granted 11 conditional standing. Any questions about that? 12 MR. MALMO: No, thank you very much. 13 I do know that at least one of the protestants never received a link for this meeting. 14 15 I don't know. MS. FLETCHER: 16 MR. MALMO: Be that as it may, we'll 17 have at least four others. 18 MS. FLETCHER: Do you know if that 19 individual provided us with their contact information? 20 21 MR. MALMO: I believe they did. 22 MS. FLETCHER: If you could be sure 23 that person did, I don't know which person that 24 is but if you would have them to provide us with

their contact information, that will be helpful.

The next thing we're going to do is 1 2 schedule a mediation, a status hearing, and a 3 protest hearing. I'm going to give you the date 4 for the protest and status hearing first. 5 The status hearing is set for September 23rd at 10:00 a.m. for the status 6 7 The protest hearing is set for October hearing. 8 -- actually, it is October 20 at 3:30 p.m. for 9 the protest hearing. We need to set a date for mediation to 10 occur prior to September 23, I'll give you the 11 12 next date available for mediation. The next day 13 available is actually a Thursday or Friday of 14 this week, if anyone wants to have mediation this 15 week. 16 If not, I'll just move to the next 17 week. 18 MR. JACKSON: What time Thursday? 19 MS. FLETCHER: Anytime between 9:00 20 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. 21 I'm available Thursday MR. JACKSON: 22 at I believe 9:00 a.m. 23 MS. FLETCHER: what about you, Mr. 24 Malmo? 25 MR. MALMO: Is that an in-person

2	MS. FLETCHER: It's going to be on		
3	WebEx, they'll send you an invitation.		
4	MR. MALMO: That should be fine.		
5	MS. FLETCHER: That's 9:00 on Thursday		
6	August 19th?		
7	MR. MALMO: Yes.		
8	MS. FLETCHER: On the 19th is this		
9	9:00 a.m.?		
10	MR. MALMO: Yes.		
11	MS. FLETCHER: Normally, only the		
12	designated representative appears for mediation		
13	but if you would like an invitation sent to any		
14	other members of the group, you can let me know.		
15	MR. MALMO: I'll let you know.		
16	MS. FLETCHER: I will send the		
17	invitation to you and you can let me know if it		
18	should be sent to any other members of the group,		
19	or you can forward them the invitation I sent to		
20	you.		
21	Either way is okay.		
22	MR. MALMO: Thank you.		
23	MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.		
24	MR. MALMO: Do we need to make sure we		
25	have at least four other members of the group at		

1	the mediation or just at the next protest
2	hearing?
3	MS. FLETCHER: That's a good question,
4	that only applies to the status hearing. For the
5	mediation it's fine if just you appear. Those
6	four individuals will need to appear at the
7	September 23 status hearing.
8	MR. MALMO: Thanks.
9	MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome, any
LO	other questions?
L1	MR. MALMO: No.
L2	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you for coming.
L3	MR. JACKSON: Thank you for having us.
L 4	MS. FLETCHER: Excuse me, one more
L5	second, please, give me one minute, just a
L6	second.
L 7	Mr. Malmo, did you provide us with
L8	your email address?
L9	MR. MALMO: Yes, I did.
20	MS. FLETCHER: I'm just checking to
21	make sure you didn't get your invitation through
22	someone else. So, we do have your email address.
23	Can you do me a favor and just tell me what it is
24	one more time?
25	You can send it by chat or you can

1	tell me.
2	MR. MALMO: I'll send it by chat.
3	MS. FLETCHER: That'll be fine. Or
4	you can email it to me, do you have my email
5	address?
6	MR. MALMO: Yes, I have your email
7	address.
8	MS. FLETCHER: You can just email it
9	to me. thank you very much.
10	MR. MALMO: Just a quick question
11	about the mediation, is there anything specific
12	and are other members of the community allowed to
13	participate in this mediation meeting?
14	MS. FLETCHER: Mediation is
15	confidential and is only between the parties,
16	it's non-adversarial and mediation is an
17	opportunity for the parties to meet and attempt
18	to resolve the protest issues if as possible by
19	way of a settlement agreement.
20	If that could be done, then the
21	protest hearing will not be necessary and will be
22	cancelled.
23	MR. MALMO: And will there be a
24	designated mediator?
25	MC FIFTCUED. Ilm the Boardic

1	Mediator so you will see me at 9:00 a.m. on the
2	19th.
3	MR. MALMO: Thank you.
4	MS. FLETCHER: And I will send you the
5	invitation.
6	MR. MALMO: Thank you.
7	MS. FLETCHER: Is that it, Mr. Malmo,
8	or anything else?
9	MR. MALMO: That's all.
10	MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Jackson?
11	MR. JACKSON: No.
12	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much,
13	the roll call hearing is concluded.
