CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We now move to our Legal Agenda, and the first matter on our Legal Agenda is to review an offer in compromising lieu of a hearing regarding Penn Quarter Sports Tavern, license no. 76039.

The offer in compromise is that the District of Columbia, jointly with the licensees respondent, to make this offer in compromise, OIC, to the Alcohol and Beverage Control Board as authorized by 23 DCMR Section 1604.5 for approval by the Board.

The parties understand that if the Board approves the OIC, this case will conclude and the schedule of Show Cause Hearing will be vacate. Respondent will be obligated to abide by the terms of the OIC define suspension, both, or other terms shown below.

If the Board does not approve the OIC, the matter will be continued to Show Cause

Hearing, which is not currently set. The

Respondent has been advised that there is no obligation to accept an OIC.

The matter is 15 Champion Kitchen, license no. 103055. 16 It is my understanding that Ms. 17 Jefferson from the Shepherd Park Citizens Association would like to address the Board 18 19 today. So I will ask Ms. Jefferson, can you 20 please un-mute your phone and do a welcome to 21 address -- bring this issue to the attention of 22 the Board. Ms. Jefferson? 23 MS. JEFFERSON: Good morning, can you 24 hear me?

Jefferson. I can hear you.

MS. JEFFERSON: Thank you. Good morning, Chair Anderson and members of the ABC Board. As he stated, my name is Naima Jefferson and I'm the president of the Shepherd Park Citizens Association.

I think I can safely say without offending any members of the Board that our community's hope was that after participating in a series of new applicant and renewal protest hearings last year, we would at least have a year or two before appearing before the Board again. Unfortunately, we are where we are.

It has been our community's hope that the upper Georgia Avenue corridor bordering Silver Spring be a safe, healthy, and thriving corridor comprising of law-abiding businesses. That hope is best demonstrated when our association has participated in cleanups, planting, as well as work with businesses to promote them even throughout the COVID pandemic to keep these businesses alive and prosperous.

The events that transpired that lead to our Board sending the August 7th letter should be a disappointment to us all at best. Our

association had expressed concerns as to whether this establishment is in fact a restaurant on numerous occasions.

As stated in our letter submitted to the Board on August 7th, the record from the renewal hearing substantiated that the licensee had been notified numerous times about violations of the DC smoking exemption laws, the settlement agree, and it's license and settlement agreement relating to seating and the capacity of patrons in the establishment.

In addition, there was an Offer of Compromise back in I believe 2019 regarding the seating and capacity as well. The events outlined in case report 19-CMP-00214 whereby one ABRA investigator informed the licensee twice about violations regarding the smoking exemption. This is in addition to the three cease and desists that were mentioned by the Department of Health as well as the numerous evidence that were submitted on the record during the protest hearing.

What this does is essentially establish that there appears to be an unwillingness for the licensee to apply with

District of Columbia law. This is particularly concerning during the public health emergency when eating at restaurants and bars have been cited by both Montgomery County and DC Health as an opportunity for community transmission of the COVID-19 virus.

Our association's request is that the case be heard, and that the license be revoked due to the aforementioned statements and circumstances, and I am open to any questions or comments from the Board. Thank you.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Ms. Jefferson, thank you for your comments regarding your concerns about Champion Kitchen and your desires that the Board hold a Show Cause hearing.

Please know that the Board had case number 19-CMP-00214 scheduled for us as Status Hearing on April 15th, 2020, and for a Show Cause hearing schedule on June 10th, 2020.
Unfortunately, due to the COVID health emergency, all of the Board hearings, not just Champion Kitchen, were continued to a date to be determined.

It is a Board's intention to resume
Status and Show Cause hearings in October. Until

then, I'm referring your letter to the Enforcement Division to continue with its monitoring of the establishment, and it's investigation of any alleged violation.

Thank you, Ms. Jefferson. We're not going to have any questions to ask you. We did ask for an opportunity to address the Board and so we're affording you the opportunity. But the Board, we will forward this matter to enforcement for further action.
