3 MS. FLETCHER: And so, Mr.

4 Silverstein, what I'll do -- I showed up just  
5 like you, and I'm going to just note for the  
6 record what transpired within the last couple  
7 minutes.

8 So what I'd like to say is, this is  
9 the matter of Baby Shank, Case Number 22-PRO-  
10 00079. This is a Retailer Class CR, a new  
11 application. The License Number is ABRA 121545,  
12 the address is 1602 U Street Northwest. And the  
13 protest issues are adverse impact on peace,  
14 order, and quiet.

15 My name is LaVerne Fletcher,  
16 conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's  
17 agent. And, just for the record, as you said,  
18 Mr. Silverstein, this matter was resolved just a  
19 couple of minutes ago -- just before we all  
20 showed up. And so, I decided to appear just to  
21 make a record of that.

22 Mr. Silverstein, could you spell your  
23 name for the record, please?

24 MR. SILVERSTEIN: M-I-K-E, S-I-L-V-E-  
25 R-S-T-E-I-N.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And so, for  
2 the record, I did receive email confirmation from  
3 the Applicant's attorney, and ANC -- excuse me --  
4 ANC 2B Chair, confirming that the two versions of  
5 the settlement agreements that were signed are  
6 identical. And so, we consider that to be a  
7 agreement that was reached prior to the roll call  
8 hearing.

9 So, Mr. Silverstein, is that your  
10 understanding as well?

11 MR. SILVERSTEIN: That is my  
12 understanding as well.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Well, in the case, Mr.  
14 Silverstein, it's nice to see you this morning.

15 MR. SILVERSTEIN: Always good to see  
16 you, Ms. Fletcher --

17 (Simultaneous speaking.)

18 MS. FLETCHER: And to hear from you.

19 MR. SILVERSTEIN: As well. And I hope  
20 the rest of the week goes as well as this does.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Well, thank you very  
22 much, it's off to a good start.

23 Okay, well then, Mr. Silverstein, I'll  
24 sign off. See you next time.

25 MR. SILVERSTEIN: Thank you so much.

1 Have a great day off. Bye-bye.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, you too. Thank  
3 you. Bye, Mr. Morris. Thank you.

4 (No audible response.)

5 MS. FLETCHER: You too. Thank you  
6 very much.
