3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So we now move  
4 to our show-cause hearing calendar. Case No. 22-  
5 251-00005, Lost Society, License No. 83420.

6 Mr. Oriana, can you please elevate the  
7 rights of the Licensee and the Government in this  
8 case? And I believe that Mr. -- I believe that  
9 Mr. Bianco is the Licensee for Lost Society, I  
10 believe.

11 MR. ORIANA: Chris Southcott, your  
12 access has been elevated. Richard Bianco, your  
13 access has been elevated.

14 MR. BIANCO: Thank you. Mr. Chair, I  
15 am not counsel on this case.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Sorry. This is  
17 Lost City. Thank you, Mr. Bianco. Let me see.  
18 Lost Society -- Lost Society. Okay, Lost  
19 Society. Is Mr. Vassey -- Is there a Mr. Vassey  
20 or -- Okay, Mr. -- Okay.

21 MR. SOUTHCOTT: Chairperson Anderson,  
22 if it would be useful, present counsel in this  
23 case did send a courtesy note to the Board  
24 earlier this morning indicating that he has a  
25 conflict where he has needs to be in Arlington

1 County for a criminal matter this morning. So he  
2 indicated that he's not going to be present.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you, Mr.  
4 Southcott. Okay. Good morning, again. Can you  
5 please spell and state your name for the record  
6 and identify yourself please, sir?

7 MR. SOUTHCOTT: My name is Chris  
8 Southcott, C-H-R-I-S, last name S-O-U-T-H-C-O-T-T  
9 from the Office of the Attorney General.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.  
11 And as been's represented, counsel for -- counsel  
12 for the Licensee is unable to attend, but that is  
13 not a concern here. So this matter then is  
14 scheduled for a show-cause hearing. If this  
15 matter's not settled, it's scheduled for a show-  
16 cause hearing on September 21, 2022 at 1:30 p.m.  
17 And I will advise you, Mr. Southcott that seven  
18 days prior to the hearing, the Government, along  
19 with the Licensee are required to provide -- to  
20 exchange documents of witnesses that they are  
21 going to rely on if this matter goes to a  
22 hearing. All right. Thank you, sir.
