The first one is Sandbox Restaurant. This is Case No. 22-PRO-00070. Wyoming Cube & Bale, LLC. 3251 Prospect Street NW. License No. ABRA-110062. This is a Retailer Class CR license renewal. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet.

24	strange situation. The owner of the license had				
25	died, the person with whom I always spoke. I				

called the management and told them that I would be calling a vote for CAG. And I did it seven days in advance.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.

Okay. So Mr. Murphy or Ms. Cruse, have you had any communication with the ownership of Sandbox, prior to today, related to a settlement agreement?

MR. MURPHY: I will speak first. I have not. And, as Ms. Cruse noted, Mr. Elliott, who was the managing partner of Wyoming Cube & Bale, LLC, passed away earlier this year. And I don't know what the ownership situation is there. The restaurant itself has been closed for quite some time. There's no activity that I know of, and I haven't seen any in quite some time. I just do not know what the situation is.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you for that. And I'll just have to look into that. The application is dismissed because there's no one present on behalf of the establishment. A WebEx invitation was sent, but maybe it didn't reach the right person. But I'll look into that and get back to you. But for the purpose of the roll call hearing today, the application is
