CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: As chairperson of the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board for the District of Columbia and in accordance with D.C. Code Section 2571(c) of the Open Meetings Act, OMA, I am welcoming you to the regularly scheduled meeting of the Alcoholic Beverage Cannabis Board. This meeting is being conducted pursuant to guidance made available by the District of Columbia's Office of Open Government regarding electronic meetings held by public bodies.

Electronic meetings by the ABC Board are authorized pursuant to Section 2577(a) of the D.C. Code. Pursuant to the OMA requirements, notice of today's meeting was provided 48 hours in advance of the meeting on ABCA's website and on the District's central meeting calendar. The notice included the, time, date, agenda, and call in or log in information for public participation.

This electronic meeting is being hosted by a Webex account provided by the District of Columbia government. Please address

I would like to 5 introduce the other members of the ABC Board who are also participating electronically. Please 6 7 respond when I announce your name. Mr. James 8 Short? 9 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. James Short, 10 present. 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Bobby Cato? 12 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, present. 13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Jeni 14 Hansen? 15 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, present. 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Edward Grandis? 17 18 MEMBER GRANDIS: Present. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The Board has 20 five members in attendance for the conduct of 21 business today and that constitutes a quorum. 2.2 Before we get underway with today's hearing 23 calendar, I need to make a few instructions very 2.4 clear so that the conduct of these hearings is 25 understood by everyone. There are six cases

scheduled for this morning's calendar.

Once your case is called, I will take a moment for IT specialist to elevate the rights for each party to enable their camera and equipment. Then and only then will you have the ability to enable your equipment. If your case has not been hearing, you will remain mute and your camera will be disabled.

At the conclusion of each case, the parties will have the option to leave. If a party chooses to stay, all cameras and microphones for the concluded case will be disabled. Should you have any questions or require technical assistance during the hearing, please submit them using the question and answer feature.

I want to apologize to the public this morning that we are late in starting. But as you are aware, the Board was on recess for the past three weeks. And we had a lot of administrative work to do this morning.

So the hour that's usually allotted to our administrative work was not sufficient this morning. And so I do apologize that we are somewhat late in starting this morning. With

that said, the first case that's on our calendar today is Case No. 23-PRO-00060, Medusa Lounge, License No. 121559. Good morning, Mr. Orellana. Can you please elevate the rights of the licensee and the protestant in this case.

MR. ORELLANA: Good morning. Josh Jacobson, your access has been elevated. And that appears to be all, Chairman. I do have communication with Josh concerning notifying Dawit Sermolo.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Meaning what has it that's been said? That is the licensee.

I'm sorry. That is the licensee. What's the communication?

MR. ORELLANA: Yeah, I made sure that he's attending. I haven't heard back from him yet and tried calling and didn't get a response. I can give a quick summary of where we're at if that helps.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well, he has to be here. So the bottom line is that if he's not here, then I need to make a motion to dismiss his application. So I know that this matter was scheduled for a protest hearing.

1 is now 10:51. So I'll just again, Mr. Orellana, 2 can you just basically put a call out in the 3 chat? Is there anyone here for Medusa 4 5 And if not, I will call the case and I'll move on. So Mr. Orellana, can you please --6 7 (Simultaneous speaking.) 8 MR. ORELLANA: Yes, will do. No 9 response, Chairman. 10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Oh, okay. So 11 all right. So let me have Mr. Jacobson, can you 12 please introduce yourself for the record, please? 13 MR. JACOBSON: Yeah, I am Commissioner 14 Josh Jacobson representing ANC1E06. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And can you 16 just -- we have a court reporter. Can you spell 17 your name for the record, please, sir? 18 MR. JACOBSON: Yes, that is Josh, J-O-19 S-H, Jacobson, J-A-C-O-B-S-O-N. 20 Thank you, sir. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 21 All right. This matter is scheduled for a 2.2 protest status hearing this morning. This matter 23 was scheduled for the hearing at 10:30 -- to start at 10:30 this morning. I called this case 2.4 25 at 10:49, and the ANC is here.

But the applicant is not here. And is stated in the roll call hearing, both the protestant and the applicant must appear at the show cause -- I'm sorry, the protest hearing status. Because the applicant is not here today, I will make a motion that their license renewal application will be dismissed.

The licensee will have ten days from today's date to provide the Board with reasonable cause why they failed to appear today. If they fail to provide the Board with reasonable cause why they failed to appear today, their application will be dismissed and they will have to start the process back over. If that is the case, then the ANC's protest -- all that the ANC has to do is just to send a letter to the agency to ask that their protest application be grandfathered in if the renewal application is submitted.

So with that, I make a motion that their renewal application for Medusa Lounge be dismissed based on the failure of the licensee to appear at the hearing this morning. Is there a second?

MEMBER SHORT: Short, I second.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has second the motion. We'll now have a roll call vote. Mr. Short?

MEMBER SHORT: Short, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

MEMBER CATO: Cato, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

(No audible response.)

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis and I agree. The matter passed 5-0-0. So basically as I've stated before, we're dismissing his renewal application. He has ten days to contact the agency.

From once this decision is issued, he'll have ten days to contact the agency, provide reasonable notice why he failed to appear today. If that is not done, then his application will be dismissed and he will have to start the process back over to renew his license. And if that is done, then the ANC can request that it's -- the ANC still believes that it wants to protest the renewal application, all the ANC has to do is to ask the agency to grandfather its
