Now, this is Show Cause Hearing. So Mr. Lutes, are there any preliminary matters in this case?

MR. LUTES: Yes, Mr. Chairman. There are preliminary matters. I'm happy to inform the Board that the District and the Licensee have come to, have settled the matter. And specifically I've entered into a Global Offer in Compromise regarding both this matter as well as another matter. At this point, the District and the Licensee don't have the finalized document prepared to submit to the Board but the District and the Licensee are prepared to read the terms of the Global Offer in Compromise onto the record.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, you're saying it's a Global. So, let's first do Case Number 21-CIT-00139. What are the terms of that case?

MR. LUTES: One second. The case at hand is 22-CIT-00154, not 39, is that correct?

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: On the calendar today the case that I have is Case Number 21-CIT-00139. That's the case that's on our published calendar.

Now, that's the calendar that I'm 1 2 looking at. If something else has changed, but 3 that's the calendar that I'm reading. So, is 4 there another calendar. That's the case I just 5 called. MR. LUTES: So, the Case Number I 6 7 actually have is the case I've prepared today is 8 22-CIT-00154. They have a calendar. However, 9 it's -- I don't believe it's the one that's 10 currently posted on ABRA's website. 11 With the Board's indulgence, I will go 12 check. 13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Oh, I'm sorry. 14 Mr. Lutes? 15 MR. LUTES: Yes. 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Lutes, I am 17 the one who has confused the case, okay? I 18 apologize. I'm the one who, because it appears 19 that I can't read today. The case that I called 20 is the case that was 22-CIT-00154, the Heights. 21 I apologize. 22 So, that's on our calendar today. 23 please let me know, you said you have a Global 24 Settlement. So, what is the settlement terms for

Case Number 22-CIT-00154?

MR. LUTES: Yes, Mr. Chairperson. 1 2 The settlement terms for Charge 1 is 3 that no ABC Manager on Duty, violation of statutory Authority, D.C. Code 25701. 4 There 5 would be a fine of \$250 payable within 60 days of the Board's accepting the Offer in Compromise and 6 7 if a payment is not made in 60 days the license 8 will be suspended until payment is received. 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Is that 10 the only charge in the case? 11 MR. LUTES: That is the only charge in 12 the case. The District is happy to also read off the other case in which the Offer in Compromise 13 14 encompasses. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 16 what's the other case? 17 MR. LUTES: The other case is Case Number 22-CIT-00205. It should have the same 18 19 case heading or same, yes, case heading. 20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. 21 MR. LUTES: Charge Number 1 is the sole 22 charge is No ABC Manager on Duty, in violation of 23 Statutory Authority of D.C. Code 25701. The fine 24 would be a \$250 fine, payable within 60 days of

the Board accepting the Offer in Compromise.

1 a payment is not made within 60 days the license 2 will be suspended until payment is received. 3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: That's it? 4 MR. LUTES: There are no further 5 charges. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 6 7 Thank you. Mr. Lumukanda, it's my understanding 8 9 that for Case Number 22-CIT-00154 there's an Offer in Compromise. And the Offer in Compromise 10 11 is a fine of \$250 payable within 60 days. 12 fine is not paid within 60 days the license will 13 be suspended until the fine has been paid. 14 That the parties have also agreed to 15 settle Case Number 22-CIT-000205 and that they also agreed to a fine of \$250 payable within 60 16 17 If the fine has not been paid within 60 18 days the license will be suspended until the fine 19 has been paid. 20 Is this your understanding, sir, of 21 the Offer in Compromise? 22 Mr. Lumukanda? 23 MR. LUMUKANDA: Yes. Yes, this is my 24 understanding. 25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client

aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise 1 2 they give up their right to a hearing? Is your 3 client also aware that --MR. LUMUKANDA: Yes, sir. 4 5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: -- accepting an Offer in Compromise that they're giving up their 6 7 right to appeal this matter? 8 MR. LUMUKANDA: Yes, sir. 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are there any 10 questions by any Board Members regarding the 11 Offer in Compromise? 12 If there are no questions by any Board Member I therefore make a motion that the Offer 13 14 in Compromise for Case Number 22-CIT-00154 offer 15 a \$250 find payable within 60 days. If the fine has not been paid within 60 days the license will 16 17 be suspended until the fine has been paid. And for in Case Number 22-CIT-00205 18 19 that there is a fine of \$250 payable in 60 days. If the fine is not paid within 60 days the 20 21 license will be suspended indefinitely until the 22 fine has been paid and accepted. 23 Is there a second? 24 MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett seconds.
