The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met via Video Teleconference, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

MS. FLETCHER: So who's going to be the designated representative for the whole group?

MR. MEHMETALLAH: Me, George.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, George. Thank
you. We have you listed as a designated
representative from the -- for the group. There
are four of you present today. This is a group
of five. I'm going to grant conditional standing
to the group of four.

What that means is that at the upcoming status hearing, that fifth person needs to appear in person. And we'll proceed with a group of five granted conditional standing. And when that fifth person appears for the status hearing who's not present today, the Board will grant full standing to the group.

The applicant is not present.

Therefore, we're going to have to dismiss the application because the applicant is not present.

The application to renew the license is dismissed.

The applicant will have 10 days to

seek reinstatement of the application from the Board. The parties will receive an order from the Board dismissing the application, and the applicant will have 10 days to seek reinstatement of the application. Can you hear me okay?

MS. AYLO: Yes.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, good. You'll receive a copy of the Board order also dismissing the application. And if they seek reinstatement, you'll be informed of that.

At that time we will schedule a date for mediation, a status hearing, and a protest hearing. But for the purpose of the roll call hearing today, the application is dismissed because the applicant has failed to appear.

MR. MEHMETALLAH: May I address you Ms. LaVerne?

MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

MR. MEHMETALLAH: So, last time we had the same issue and he failed to show up, and then we started again like now. I mean, if this keeps going on, what is the solution because we cannot just kick work every time and then he doesn't show up.

MS. FLETCHER: You can bring that to

1	the attention of the Board. I will mention it in
2	my notes and we'll go from there. But I'll let
3	them know in my notes that this has happened
4	before.
5	MR. MEHMETALLAH: Correct.
6	MS. FLETCHER: But thank you all for
7	participating and we'll keep you posted.
8	MS. AYLO: Thank you.
9	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you very
10	much. Have a nice day.
11	PARTICIPANT: I have a quick question,
12	I'm sorry.
13	MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
14	PARTICIPANT: You said you needed an
15	extra participant. I think my wife is on as
16	well, Luciani Guilmard.
17	MS. FLETCHER: Oh, Okay.
18	PARTICIPANT: I think she's working
19	but I think she might be coming up any second
20	now.
21	MS. FLETCHER: All right.
22	PARTICIPANT: I apologize, if you just
23	hold. So the status is they just basically need
24	to re-file, is that correct?
25	MS. FLETCHER: Well, what will happen

is once the Board dismisses the application, they will have an opportunity to seek reinstatement. If the Board reinstates the application, we just proceed, we get back on track. I'll contact you to set a date for a mediation status hearing and a protest hearing. But they would not need to refile if the Board reinstates the application.

PARTICIPANT: Got it.

MS. FLETCHER: If the Board does not reinstate the application, then they have to start over maybe. But at this stage, we just have to wait and see if the Board will approve reinstatement of the application if they can show the Board that for good cause they did not appear today.

PARTICIPANT: Okay. So, I just a message from my wife and unfortunately she'll not be able to come up. She's working, so I apologize.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, that's fine. And her name is Rafia Aliya, yes?

PARTICIPANT: No, no, sorry. Luciani
Guilmard. I'm not sure if she was on the
original petition, but I thought she had showed
up. It could've been Chuck and Bill, so I'm not

1 sure. 2 MS. FLETCHER: I'm looking at the 3 protest letter, and the only parties that can 4 participate or be present for a roll call hearing 5 are those that actually signed the protest letter. And your wife, did she sign the protest 6 7 letter? I believe so, yes. 8 PARTICIPANT: Yes, 9 I think she did. 10 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, yes, Lucianne? 11 Yes, that's it. PARTICIPANT: 12 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So she did sign the protest letter, so she's the person that 13 14 would need to appear in person at the status 15 hearing. Everyone else is here. 16 PARTICIPANT: Okay, got it. Okay, 17 thank you. 18 MS. FLETCHER: And so Mr. -- George, 19 if I may call you George, you would appear at the 20 upcoming status hearing. You're the designated 21 representative. 22 MR. MEHMETALLAH: Sure. 23 MS. FLETCHER: And Lucianne would

appear as well because she wasn't present today.

At the time, you will be granted full-standing as

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1	a protesting group, but today you're granted				
2	conditional standing.				
3	MR. MEHMETALLAH: Understood.				
4	PARTICIPANT: Thank you.				
5	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, anything else?
