The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board met via WebEx videoconference, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the  
4 calendar is 202 Lounge One. This is Case Number  
5 23-PRO-00075, 202 Lounge One, LLC. 609 H Street  
6 Northwest, License Number ABRA 125294. This is a  
7 retailer with class CT new application. The  
8 protest issues are adverse The impact on people  
9 and quiet.

10 My name is LaVerne Fletcher,  
11 conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's  
12 agent. Is anyone present on behalf of 202 Lounge  
13 One?

14 MR. JACKSON: Yes, Ms. Fletcher. Good  
15 morning. Jeff Jackson on behalf of the  
16 Applicant.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Jackson.  
18 Would you spell your name for the record, please?

19 MR. JACKSON: Yes, ma'am. First name,  
20 J-E-F-F, last name, J-A-C-K-S-O-N.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And on  
22 behalf of ANC 2C?

23 MS. SHANKLE: Good morning, Ms.  
24 Fletcher. It's Michael Shankle, Chair of ANC 2C.  
25 M-I-C-H-A-E-L, last name, S-H-A-N-K-L-E.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Shankle.  
2 ANC 2C does have standing as a Protestant. We  
3 need to set a date for status hearing, protest  
4 hearing, and mediation. I'll give you the dates  
5 for the status and protest hearings first, the  
6 status hearing is set for October 4, 2023 at  
7 10:30 a.m. The protest hearing is set for  
8 November 8, 2023 at 1:30 p.m. I will give you  
9 the next available day for mediation, which is  
10 Friday, September 29, anytime between 10:00 and  
11 1:30. That's Friday, September 29. That's the  
12 next available day.

13 MS. SHANKLE: I am able to do 10:00  
14 o'clock, if Mr. Jackson is. Or the --

15 MR. JACKSON: The 29, I won't be  
16 available until 1:00 o'clock, or say 12:00 noon -  
17 - no, about -- I'm sorry, let me look at my  
18 schedule. I'll be available about 1:00 o'clock.

19 MS. FLETCHER: That's good on this  
20 end.

21 MS. SHANKLE: 1:00 o'clock is fine?  
22 Then, I can make 1:00 o'clock work.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

24 MS. SHANKLE: And that's for  
25 mediation, is that correct?

1 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. That is for  
2 mediation, which is set for Friday, September 29  
3 at 1:00 o'clock.

4 MS. SHANKLE: Got it. And I -- Ms.  
5 Fletcher, I have to apologize to Mr. Jackson. We  
6 have talked about a settlement agreement and I  
7 have not gotten that over to him yet, so that  
8 will be forthcoming. So, we will keep you  
9 posted.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Shankle.  
11 And you know what happens next --

12 (Simultaneous speaking.)

13 MR. JACKSON: Mr. Shankle. See, I was  
14 wondering about that.

15 MS. SHANKLE: I'm sorry about that,  
16 I've been swamped.

17 MR. JACKSON: No problem.

18 MS. FLETCHER: Well, you know what  
19 happens next. If you resolve the matter before  
20 September 29, just let us know and we'll cancel  
21 the mediation.

22 MS. SHANKLE: You got it.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, well --

24 MR. JACKSON: I think we could.

25 MS. SHANKLE: Yes, I think we can,

1 too.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Well, thank you for  
3 coming. If the matter's not resolved, I'll see  
4 you on the 29.

5 MS. SHANKLE: All right, thank you.  
6 Have a good day.

7 (Simultaneous speaking.)

8 MR. JACKSON: Thank you so much.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Alright, bye everybody.

10 (Simultaneous speaking.)

11 MS. SHANKLE: Bye, Jackson.

12 MR. JACKSON: Okay, bye-bye.

13 MS. FLETCHER: The roll call hearing  
14 in this matter is concluded.

15 MR. JACKSON: Commissioner, you can  
16 call me anytime.

17 MS. SHANKLE: You got it. Thank you.

18 MR. JACKSON: Okay, thanks.

19 MS. FLETCHER: Thanks, everybody.

20 MR. JACKSON: Okay.
