It is imperative that you review these 6 7 rules closely and adhere to them before and 8 during the Protest Hearing. 9 You are also required to complete and submit a Protest Information Form, PIF, and the 10 11 Exhibit Form, seven days before the date of the 12 hearing. 13 These two forms and accompanying documents need to be submitted to ABRA's legal 14 15 division and to all opposing parties in this 16 If we do not receive a copy of your PIF, matter. 17 your Application, or your protest, whichever side 18 you're representing may be subject to dismissal. Likewise, if we do not receive a copy 19 20 of the Exhibit Form and the Exhibits themselves, 21 your Exhibits may be excluded from the record, 2.2 upon a finding that the opposing party has been 23 prejudiced, or no good cause for failure to submit has been shown. 2.4 25 Likewise, witnesses, other than a
