5	Indian Food On The Go, License Number 92792.
6	Mr. Orellana, can you please elevate
7	the rights of the parties in this case, please.
8	MR. ORELLANA: Your access has been
9	elevated. That is all, Chairman.
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
11	Mr. Minora, can you identify yourself for the
12	record.
13	MR. MINORA: Sure. My name is Matthew
14	Minora. I'm from the law firm of Malios, O'Brien
15	and Standground. We are ABC license counsel for
16	the licensee.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.
18	Ms. Sanchez, can you please identify
19	yourself for the record, please.
20	MS. SANCHEZ: Yes. I'm Sylvia Sanchez.
21	And I'm the abutting neighbor to Indigo.
22	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Will you please

8	made efforts but I've not heard anything back.		
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And is the ANC,		
10	is there anyone from ANC 6C on this hearing,		
11	please identify yourself for the record, please.		
12	Is there anyone here from ANC 6C,		
13	please identify yourself for the record.		
14	One more time. Is there anyone here		
15	from ANC 6C, please identify yourself for the		
16	record.		
17	I'm waiting for a response. I see		
18	there is information in the Chat asking someone		
19	to identify themself. Let me wait a minute		
20	before see if there is a person.		
21	All right. This matter was scheduled		
22	for a Protest Hearing status at 10:38. It's		
23	10:48 and I've called the case and the ANC is not		
24	here. So, I'm going to make a motion to dismiss		
25	the ANC from this protest. Is there a second?

2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
3	seconded the motion. We'll now have a Roll Call
4	vote.
5	Mr. Short?
6	MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?
8	MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?
10	MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I
11	agree.
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?
13	MS. HANSEN: (No audible response.)
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?
15	MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis and I
16	agree.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.
18	Anderson, I agree. The matter passes six, zero,
19	zero.
20	What this means is that the ANC has 10
21	days. We're issuing an order dismissing the ANC
22	from this protest. The ANC will have 10 days to
23	provide a reasonable notice, good cause, why they
24	failed to appear at hearing today.
25	I just want to tell you Ms. Sanchez,

just want to let everyone know that these matters 1 are scheduled so if the ANC or if you did not 2 3 show up at the Roll Call Hearing or at the Status Hearing then we would dismiss the party. And so, 4 5 therefore, they'll have 10 days to appeal. If they fail to appeal or provide the Board notice, 6 7 good cause, why they failed to appear today. If 8 they do that then maybe we can reinstate them but 9 if not, they are dismissed from this protest. 10 So, the only protestant in t his case will be the 11 abutting property owner. 12 All right. This matter then is 13 scheduled for -- if this matter goes to a hearing 14 it is scheduled for a Protest Hearing on October 19th, 2022, at 1:30 p.m. 15 16 Any questions by anyone? 17 All right. Ms. Sanchez, if this 18 matter goes to -- let me ask you, do the parties 19 believe that this matter will be settled? 20 MS. SANCHEZ: I'm not sure at this 21 time. I did get an email over the weekend from 22 Matt and we haven't had a chance to talk. So, 23 I'm not sure. 24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. As 25 I stated before this matter is scheduled for a

Protest Hearing on October 19th, 2022. And so n ow that we've scheduled this matter for a Protest Hearing there are a few things that I would like to instruct you about because the Board's practices have changed.

As you know, the Board's hearings are conducted virtually so it is important whenever Protest Hearings ae focused and addresses only those issues that are being protested.

10 Following this hearing you'll receive 11 an email from ABRA Legal that will include a copy 12 of a protest information form and a copy of an 13 exhibit form as well as specific instructions for 14 the hearing. You are required to complete and 15 submit the PIF and exhibit form at least seven days before the date of the hearing. 16 If we do 17 not receive a copy of your forms seven days 18 before the hearing, your application or your 19 protest may be subject to dismissal.

These documents need to be submitted to ABRA Legal and to the opposing parties. Please note that these documents greatly assist the Board in narrowing the protest issues, facilitating the process and keeping the parties on point during the hearing.
